

Business is booming so much, facilities are going to be expanded at the Main St. N., building. There is still a lot of unused space in the existing structure, so an extension will not be needed for some time,

Mr. Wadland said. Ninety people are employed in Acton, with most of them in the actual plant. One woman shares the shift work with the men. Most of those working are from Acton and area.

Building Products started out as Micro-Plastics and was bought in 1960 by Building Products of Canada Limited. In Imperial Oil purchased Building Products, which still own the firm. In 1877, the Acton plant went 100 per cent Esclad Vinyl Siding.



leaders in the vinyl siding industry in Canada. Mr. Wadland explains there are six other firms manufacturing siding, so business is competitive.

A change in the siding, whether in texture, shape or color is put through almost two years of testing, before it is marketed, Mr. Wadland said. He explained the company hires independent testing firms to test their product in Arizona, Florida, Sarnia, and in Acton. This way, the siding is exposed to all ranges of temperatures. Each test on any change they decide to make takes two years using an independent agency. This assures an unblased

Mr. Wadland said there are many factors contributing escalation of the industry in the past few years.

People no longer want to be bothered painting their house. He admitted siding is more costly than a few gallons of paint, but once it is on it is permanent, and needs virtually no maintenance.

Vinyl siding is almost virtually scuff free. To demonstrate, Wadland banged sample piece repeatedly against a table. It did not

even mark. Although the firm does not attempt to make anyone believe the siding is a superior insulator, applied with a backerboard it does help with the heating bills. And now, Mr. Wadland said many people are putting insulation over their outside walls, and then covering the insulation siding. The siding itself is
