

# Local swimmers helping Marlins

Three Acton swimmers participated in the Bramford International Swim Meet last weekend to help their club, the Guelph Marlins, earn 11th place against stiff

competition from 41 clubs from Ontario, Quebec and the USA.

Mark Bray clocked an impressive 2:23 in 200 metre butterfly, besting

his previous time by eight seconds. This placed Mark five seconds faster than the standard for Division II National and will entitle him to compete in Men's Open National competition in

400 metre individual medley, the latter by 13 seconds.

Adrienne Kovacs, swimming in 10 and under girls, performed well in her several events and improved her 200 metre backstroke by 5.2 seconds. She also earned a bronze medal for her excellent effort in the 200 metre freestyle relay.

Peter Bray improved in 100 metre freestyle and bettered previous times in 50 metre butterfly and

200 metre backstroke by four seconds each. All three swimmers will compete in the North

York Hall of Fame Swim Meet, to be held at the Etobicoke Olympian in two weeks.
