OHIP might pay \$90

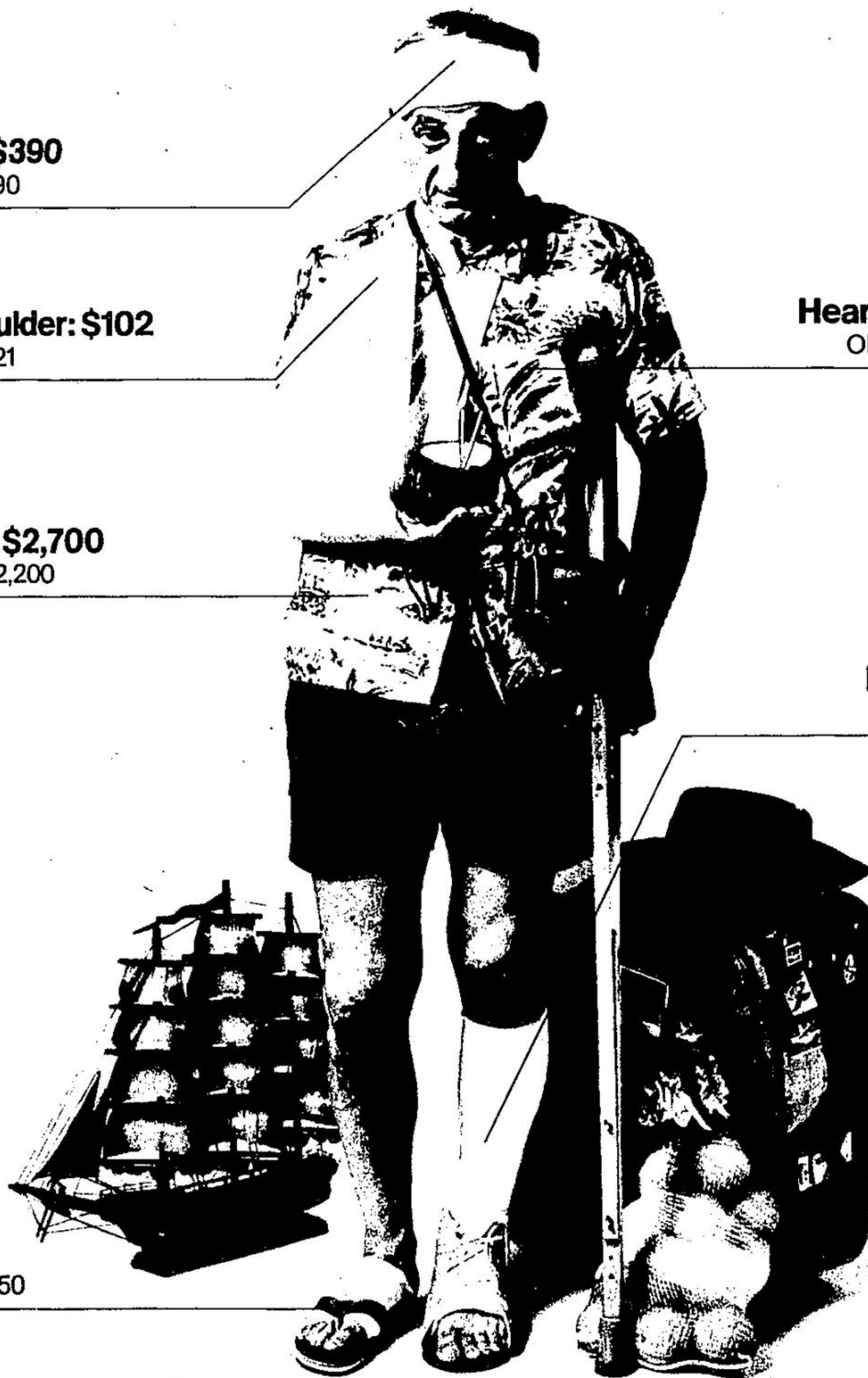
**Sprained shoulder: \$102**

OHIP might pay \$2,200

OHIP might pay \$10,000

**Broken leg: \$875**  
OHIP might pay \$283

**Jelly fish sting: \$90**  
OHIP might pay \$50



These examples are typical of what you could be charged if you have to pay hospitals and/or doctors in the United States or abroad—and what you might get back from the government health plan.

Ontario Blue Cross "Health Plan While Outside Canada" fills the gap.

\*It provides coverage with no overall

maximum for specified hospital/medical expenses over and above what OHIP pays. You can get it for yourself for 50¢ a day or your family for \$1.00 a day, from 7 to 240 days. There's no age limit. There are no restrictions due to previous medical history.
