The Outdoor Education instructor, Mr. John Little, visited Ospringle school last Monday.

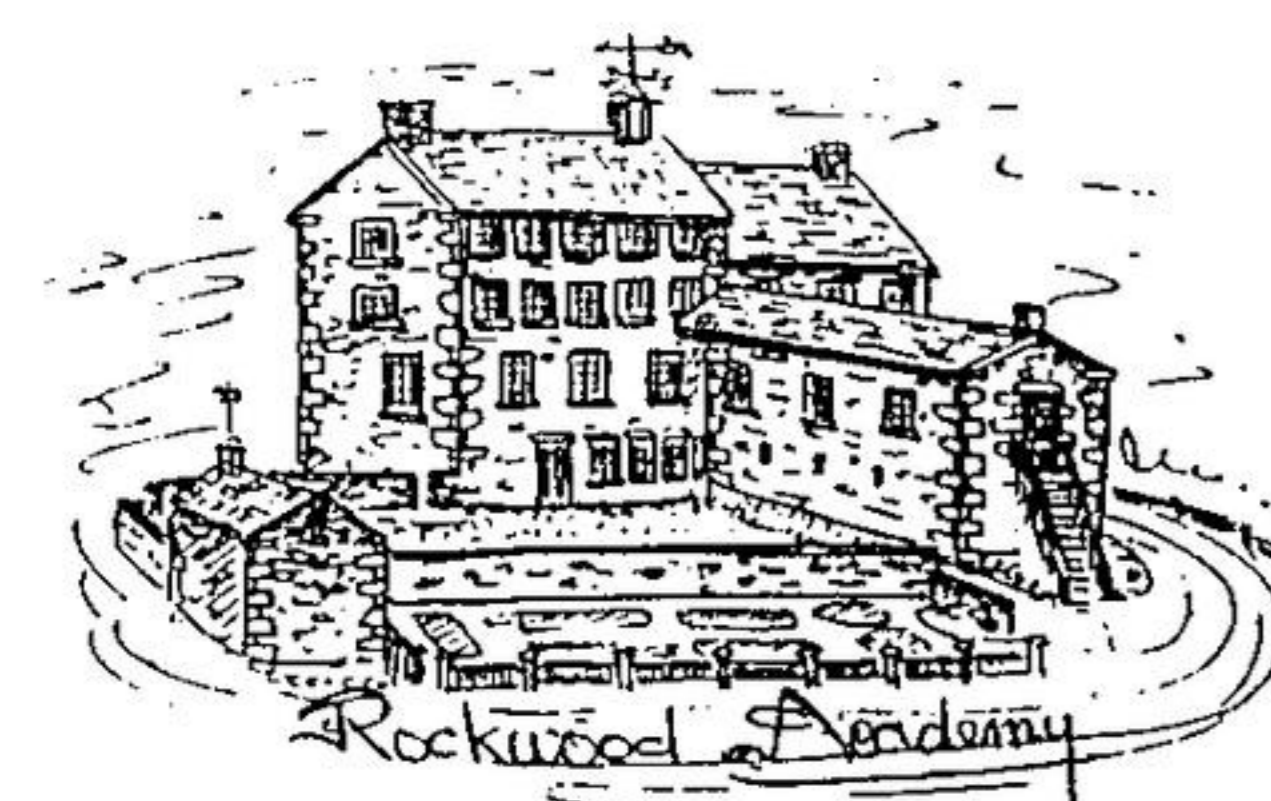
**Info centre for Hwy. 25**
