Cultural grant to Garden causes furor

A cultural grant of \$120,000 has been made by Halton Region to the Royal Botanical Gardens following a controversy which lasted more than a week.

RBG approached the budget discussions of the Administration and Finance Committee Feb. 27 seeking a grant of \$155,000 to aid in keeping the facility going.

Located on the boundaries of Halton and Hamilton-Wentworth in Burlington, the gardens had been funded by Burlington and Hamilton until this year when it was decided all requests for grants would go to the Region for discussion.

At the time, councillors were split on the need for all the people of Halton to support the facility; but it was finally decided \$128,000 would be recommended to council for a full discussion by all members at that time.

Last Wednesday the item came up and it sparked a debate which saw a split between those who felt the region owed it to the RBG to keep a world-famous garden in existence, and those who thought it was too much money to spend in light of the eight per cent guideline laid down for grants.

Those opposed were led by Bill Johnson who suggested one way the RBG might cut costs to use the services of Maplehurst Correctional Facility to keep the grounds in shape.

Groundwork is one of the major components of the RBG budget. This was lost in a recorded vote, with the \$128,000 being awarded.

Other grants approved by Council last week were: Halton Fire Prevention Committee, \$2,200; Halton Federation of Agriculture, \$3,600; Halton Agricultural Groups, \$6,250; Larne Scots Regiment, \$1,000; Hamilton Philharmonic Orchestra, \$6,000 and Festival Country, \$6,165.

Approve \$62,900 for day care

Halton Regional Councilors spent Saturday reviewing the health, family and social services budgets with the Halton Hills Day Care Centre being one of the winners.

Despite sticking rigidly to a maximum eight per cent increase, the Health and Social Services Committee has recommended council approve \$62,900 for the day care centre on Maple Ave. in Georgetown.

The amount budgeted last year was \$55,400, so the amount this year represents a 21 per cent increase.

But the question of raising day care rates to meet cost increases was also discussed and it appears possible the rate could be going up at the end of December.

Some Councilors felt the rates should rise immediately or at least before September. Most, however, felt the rates, once set, should remain in place for a year.
