Acton Business Improvement Area (BIA) secure

In a presentation to Halton Hills council Monday BIA chairman Larry Greaves noted the province has made money available at low interest rates to study downtown renewal and "it would be unwise for a community to disregard," the ald.


He sald before the money can be secured the town must have an official plan and a maintenance and occupancy by-law. Acton has an official plan so now the town must enact the maintenance and cupancy by-law Greaves observed, adding such a by-law won't "impose a hardship on anyone."

After that is done the town may initiate a study by "professional architectural-plannersconsultants to assess the potential for all aspects of renewal in the next few years." Greaves said the cost of the study would be picked up by Queen's Park and the BIA and municipal costs would be "minimal." Town costs would likely amount to just staff man-hours.


