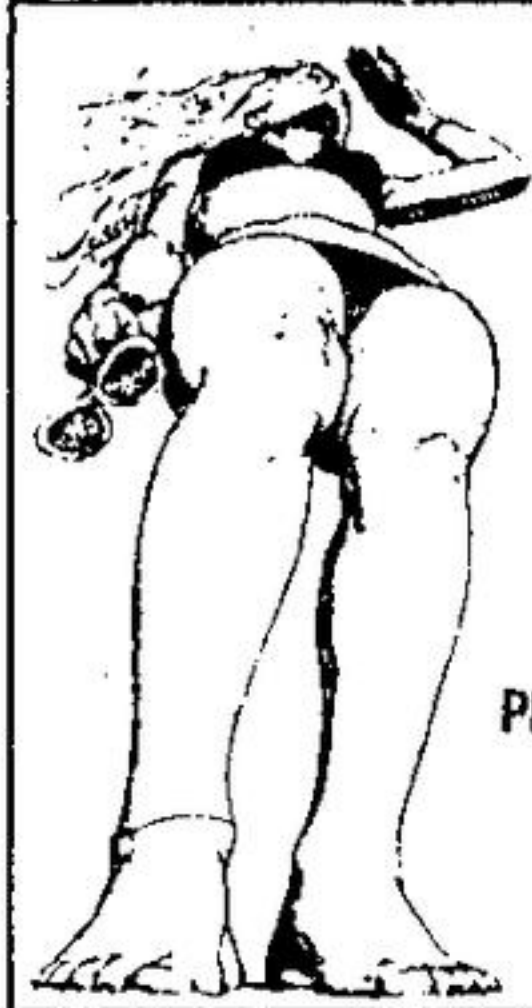

Student Manpower

A Student Manpower office is now open in Georgetown to assist Acton youngsters in finding jobs for this summer.

The office, under the supervision of Erika Harper is situated in Glenview Square, right next to last year's location.

Students wishing to register for summer employment may visit the Georgetown office to register.

Ms. Harper says she plans on attending Acton High School to speak to students and hand out registration forms, but isn't sure of the date.

The student manpower office finds it has more business from Georgetown, Ms. Harper said, who was also last year's superintendent. Acton employers tend to want Acton students for work and hire through "word of mouth" recommendations.

Seniors tax credits \$300

There's \$300 per year available in tax credits to Halton Hills senior citizens.

Applications for the two types of tax credits may be made through the town.

The most popular credit requires an application be made by September. About 60 residents applied last year. This tax break comes under provincial legislation entitled The Municipal Elderly Residence Act.

Under the act a \$150 tax credit can be received by residents 65 years of age or older. They must have lived in a residence which they own for five consecutive years.

"As long as they receive the Guaranteed Annual Supplement from Ottawa they get the \$150," Halton Hills tax department official Grant Usher said in an interview Tuesday.

Halton Hills recently increased the credit to \$150 from \$100.

Applications to the town are verified with Ottawa.

The second form of tax credit is less popular, although it also is for \$150. About 11 people applied for the Municipal and School Tax Credit Assistance Act benefit, although all of the 80 who applied for the first break, qualified for the second.

This is not a grant like the first tax credit, it is a lien which is registered against the property.

If the applicant for this tax credit sells the property or dies, the estate must reimburse the province, at no interest, for the amount registered on title.
