Figure skating Club begins season

One new feature is a national badge test co-ordinator, who will be testing the students each month. Plans for the test days will be set by registration time and distributed to the parents with the newsletter and skating program.

All levels of skaters from pre-schoolers to intermediates will be tested monthly. There will be no interruption in the teaching routines of

Also when a student passes three of the four requirements for a badge, he or she is allowed to advance to the next level. Of course subsequent badges will not be awarded until the fourth requirement has

been met. This is a new rule designed to act as an incentive for skaters.

Lack of communication was a problem in the past year. As a result, the executive hopes to be more available to the parents in the upcoming season. For the 1980-81 season, we are going to put a positive approach into practice.

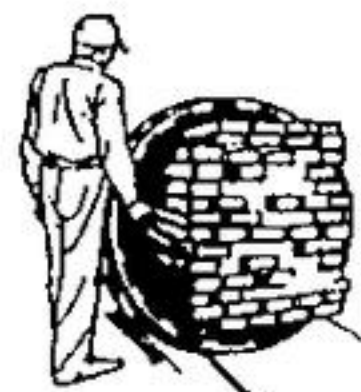

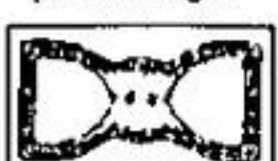
