SCALE THE HEIGHTS AND LEARN THE LORE

Heritage Park. North to bustling Edmonton for two nights. And lots of shopping along Jasper Avenue. Or a smooth ride on Canada's newest light-rail transit system. In the afternoon it's all-aboard the Super Continental for home. Lying back in the glass dome and soaking up the super scenery. Even the Fraser Valley looks different on the westbound trip back! CARIBOO-CHILCOTIN DISCOVERER

Eight days of scenery and history make this tour an education in itself. Start in Vancouver and take the most scenic rail trip in North America, the British Columbia Railway to the Cariboo-Chilcotin region. For 200 miles there's a continuous panorama of mountains, rivers, lakes, gorges; and an incredible climb up the Fraser Canyon from water level to a narrow ledge 3,000 feet above the river! Into ranching country and a day in Williams Lake. Then onward to Quesnel. A bus to Barkerville, the gold rush capital of the Cariboo. And a visit to Barkerville Historical Park, See a wooden waterwheel and relics of the 1860 Cariboo Gold Rush at Quesnel Museum.

A bus takes you to Prince George for '

an overnight stop. Then the Skeena takes you along the Yellowhead route to Bulkley River Canyon. Another bus at Hazelton to the "K SAN", a Gitksan Indian village. Where you learn some of the lore of the tribe in authentic longhouses. All this is at the junction of the Skeena and Bulkley Rivers and under Rocher Deboule Mountain. A breathtaking setting. Here there's the greatest number of totem poles in Canada. A day in Prince Rupert, halibut capital of the world. Return on Skeena to Jasper along the Skeena River. Which boasts villages on stilts; Scandinavian fjords; waterfalls; canyons; mountains; and the impressive Kathyln Glacier on Hudson Bay Mountain. View towering Mount Robson before arriving Jasper; dine at Jasper Park Lodge which overlooks Lac Beauvert, Cruise around Maligne Lake and Canyon. The Super Continental takes you back to Vancouver. VIA SE-28 \$475, from Vancouver.

From the train photograph mountains, waterfalls, canyons, a glistening glacier, fjords, fishing villages on stilts. Visit a Gitksan village to learn Indian longhouse fore. Finale includes all-day scenic trip on British Columbia Railway. Continuous panorama of ranchlands, canyons, mountains, lakes, rivers, gorges. Breathtaking view of Fraser Canyon from a ledge 3,000 feet above water level.
