

Sensitive areas protected

Three areas in Halton cut from the original Niagara Escarpment Plan are already protected by the sensitive area designation in Halton's Official Plan and no longer require the NEC plan protection, Planner Mario Venditti told this newspaper.

The areas were noted when The Coalition of the Niagara Escarpment (CONE) at hearings in Ancaster this week protested the cutting of the area controlled by the NEC from 1,970 square miles to 742 square miles.

The three Halton areas among ten cited, include a pond area near Ballinacree, on the north-east side of the Seventh Line, said to contain unique forms of plant life; a swamp area about one mile south of the sewage plant in Acton, near Indusmin quarries; and Hilton Falls on the opposite of Highway 401 from Kelso Conservation Area.

CONE wants the province to order officials conducting the public hearing in Ancaster to consider expanding the 742 square mile area now in the revised NEC plan.

Sludge law sought

Halton Region's legal department has been asked to prepare a resolution which would ban the importation of sewage sludge from other areas to be dumped in Halton.

The request has been made by the Public Works Committee following a resolution from the Halton Agricultural Advisory Committee which expressed concern over the quality and quantity being brought into Halton, notably from Peel Region.

Nursing union opposed

Regional Solicitor Dennis Perlin and Regional Personnel Director Dennis Camm have been given council permission to make representations to block a unionizing move inside Halton Centennial Manor.

The two regional staff members will make the case of Halton Region known to the Ontario Labor Relations Board regarding an application for certification by the Ontario Nurses' Association as the bargaining units for the registered and graduate nurses at the Manor.

Halton Manor employs 12 full time and nine part time registered nurses in addition to a director and assistant director of nursing, and administrator Jack Charlton.
