Drug report figures

The following is a selection of some of the findings in the Halton Addition Research Foundation's survey of drug and alcohol use in Halton secondary schools.

The survey was performed in November at Oakville Trafalgar High School, however, the foundation contends the findings could have come from "another local high school with a general student population."

There are about 19,000 high school students in Halton. By applying the Oakville results across the region the "minimum frequency of use" was found to be as follows: two per cent are regular users of cannabis in Grade nine, while six per cent regularly use alcohol.

Cannabis peaks at 12 per cent of the school population in Grade 12. It declines to 11 per cent in the final year; the same level as grade 11.

Meanwhile alcohol use climbs to 42 per cent in grade 13.

From the Oakville Trafalgar population "there were significant numbers of regular users" of alcohol and cannabis, according to the report.

Twenty-six per cent of the students who used alcohol in the past year drank at least once a week. Weekly use of cannabis was reported by ten per cent of the students.

Five per cent of the students reported that their parents felt the students drank too much. "In the same context, 36 per cent of the male and 41 per cent of the female drinkers said their parents did not know how much they drank."

Fourteen per cent of the students said they wanted nothing when asked what they would most like to learn about alcohol. Forty-one per cent of the boys and 58 per cent of the girls "wanted a variety of topics discussed." They also favored using an alcohol expert or ex-user to lead classes. Only four per cent preferred teacher led classes.

Twenty-five per cent of the students said they attended classes at least once after using alcohol or other drugs. Nine per cent had done so six or more times.

Thirty-five per cent attended school sponsored extra-curricular activities after using alcohol or drugs. Boys reported this behavior six or more times.

Summer school staff prepares

Halton Board of Education's summer school office staff is busy processing registrations and finalizing arrangements for the elementary and secondary school summer programs.

Classes will be offered for South Asian refugees and other children ages 10-14 in the elementary system. These classes are a continuation of English and mathematics program presently conducted in the schools. Sponsors interested in programs for these classes can be organized at convenient sites. The aim of these classes is to prepare the youngsters for complete integration into the regular school program this September.

Elementary classes are formed in senior elementary schools throughout Halton where there is sufficient enrollment. Transportation is the responsibility of the student. The fee for each course is \$5. Classes are one and a half hours long and sessions are held from 8:30 a.m. to 10 a.m., and 10:30 to 12.

The elementary courses begin on July 2 and end August 1.

Refund eight to 10 weeks

People expecting income tax refunds this year can expect to wait eight to ten weeks for their refund cheques because of a late start in processing at Revenue Canada's four Taxation Centres.

She has studied privately under such well known pianists as Pierre Souvassian and Clifford Poole, also studied conducting with Victor Feldbrill who was Andrew Davis' predecessor as conductor of the Toronto Symphony Orchestra.

There is no admission charge for the concert which is open to parents of all students at the school, those whose children plan to attend there next year, and the people of the community interested in music.
