The Polar Dear Express

The Polar Bear Express is an exciting day trip "down" to the Arctic tidewater of James Bay, which is part of Hudson Bay.

The Express travels through untouched wilderness, where the only inhabitants are trappers and the local Indians. The trip ends in Moosonee, and the train returns to Cochrane the same day.

Or a visitor can make it into a two-day trip on the slow "local", which carries a colorful assortment of trappers, Indians, hunters, adventurers, and geologists, along with excited, happy tourists. The train stops wherever anyone wishes to get on

or off, as there are very few stations.

The passenger on this version of the Polar Bear Express must spend the night at one of the lodges (bookings are essential) and return to Cochrane the next day. Whichever way a traveller chooses, it's an exciting frontier experience. During the summer months, the Polar Bear Express is a pretty lively train, with sing-songs, "tall lales" and a generally friendly, feative atmosphere.
