

# Stop Lock Walk Talk works

A "Stop, Lock, Walk and Talk" program kicked off by regional police in northern Halton has proven successful in recent months, according to Chief James Harding. More than 1,000 hours of foot patrol were logged by 150 officers during May, he told police commissioners Thursday. He added it was the dedication of the officers that made it possible, particularly during a month that required considerable police manpower at three different labor strikes in the area. Local business proprietors and politicians have complained frequently police are not as visible on town streets as they should be.

# \$2,400 damage in crash

A collision at the Ballinafad and Trafalgar Road intersection, Friday night around 11:30 resulted in a total \$2,400 damage.

Cars driven by Brian Irvine, Grand Valley and John Hancock, Garafra were involved in the crash. Damage to the Irvine car is estimated at \$1,800 and to the Hancock car \$600.

# Police building over budget

Estimated construction costs of a new wing on the Halton Regional Police headquarters building in Oakville are well over budget, but police commission members are determined to keep within the \$390,000 price limit set on the addition.

All six construction firms vying for the job failed to meet the budget, with the lowest bid of \$223,000 submitted by Q. Sons Construction Company, Willowdale.

The bids were opened Thursday afternoon at a meeting of police commission members and Don Wilson, an architect hired by the commission for the job of the wing.

Costs must be trimmed to fit the budget, police commission chairman Harry Barrett told Mr. Wilson.

"It is imperative to stay within the budget and we are prepared for some changes," he said, noting he had assured the region the project would be done for the original price tag.

Mr. Wilson said he will make his recommendation of a tender in approximately one week with further suggestions on cutting back expenses.

The expansion of the Oakville headquarters represents the largest capital project this year for the force and is intended to amalgamate all officers in District 2 under one roof.

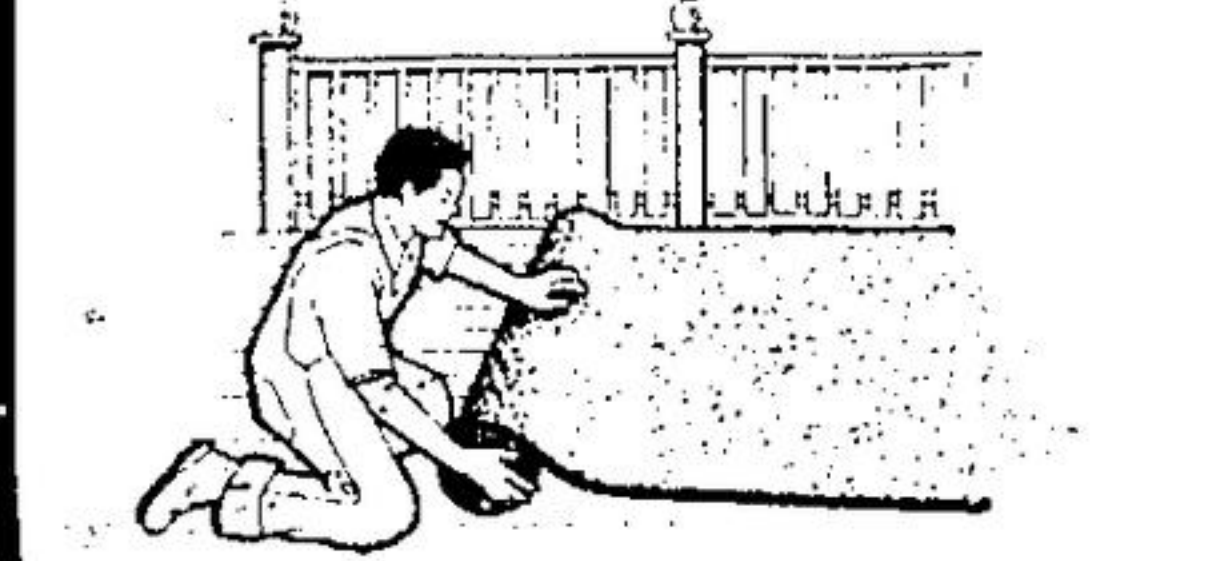

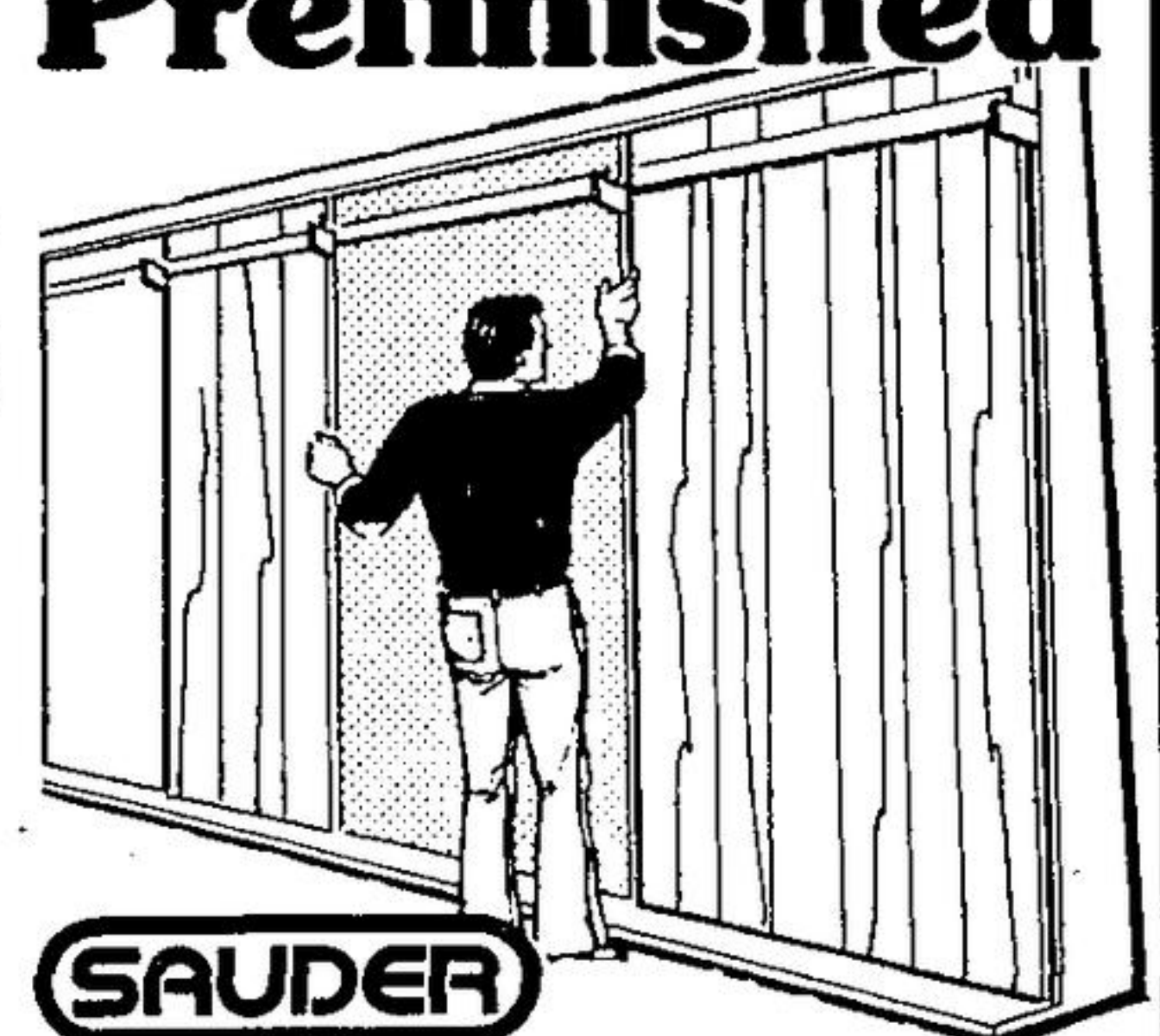
