Police building over budget

Estimated construction costs of a new wing on the Halton Regional headquarters building in Oakville are well over budget, but police commission members are determined to keep within the \$890,000 price limit set on the addition.

All six construction firms vying for the job failed to meet the budget, with the lowest bld of \$223,000 submitted by Q. Sons Construction Com-

pany, Willowdale. The bids were opened Thursday afternoon at a meeting of police commission members and Don Wilson, an architect hired by the commission for the job of the wing.

Costs must be trimmed to fit the budget, police commission chairman Harry Barrett told Mr. Wilson.

"It is imperative to stay within the budget and we are prepared for some changes," he said, noting he had assured the region the project would be done for the original

price tag. Mr. Wilson said he will make his recommendation of a tender in approximately one week with further suggestions

on cutting back exenses. The expansion of the Oakville headquarters represents the largest capital project this year for the force and is intended to amalgamate all officers in District 2 under one roof.
