



including start-up, train- The purpose of this amendment is to change the designation of certain lands deaggressive 'scribed herein from "Rural" to "Industrial".

Ontario to date. Many This amendment applies to approximately 29 hectares (72 ocres) of land in the former Township of Esquesing indicated above and described as follows:

> i) part of the Southwest Half of Lot 5 of Concession 3, and (ii) bounded on the West by the Highway No. 25, on the North by the Campbellville Road (No. 5 Side Road), on the East by the Westerly limit of the proposed Nanticoke-Pickering Hydro Corridor, and on the South by a line that is parallel to the South limit of Lot 4 in concession 3 and situated approximately 115 metres (377 feet) North of that lot line.

Basis for The Amendment

Amendment No. 7 to the Official Plan of the Milton Planning Area, changed the de-Agent required for high signation of 562 hectares (1,388 acres) of land situated to the South, Southwest and volume self-serve with Southeast of the subject lands, from "Rural" to "Industrial". 
