### Students hired to keep core clean

Two Acton High School students are spending their summer keeping downtown clean as part of a Business Improvement Area (BIA) plan. The two students, Debbie Thornhill, 18 and Tim Evans 16, have been on the streets since May, sweeping the sidewalks, watering the plants and picking up garbage in the parking lots.

Henry Stachyra of First Line TV, who is a member of the board of management of the BIA and is in charge of the project, said the two are kept "pretty busy".

"They had been working part-time in May and June and began fulltime when the school term was over."

Stachyra said this is the third year of operation of the program with two different students hired each summer. He added 90 per cent of the students' wages came from a grant via the Ministry of Housing's Community Renewal Branch.

## Lots of casual work but few full-time jobs

There are casual labor jobs for Acton and area students this summer, but few are finding full-time employment.

According to Brent Brooks of Student Manpower in Georgetown, which serves Acton and area, most work for students this year ranges from a few days up to two weeks.

He reports 1,000 students have registered

for work, about a quarter of them from Acton and area.

The economy is pretty depressed this summer, he notes, so while there are "quite a few jobs" few last the entire summer.

Students are finding work on farms during haying and picking fruit, Brooks reports. There are a lot of casual, short term jobs, available helping homeowners

make repairs, painting, build fences, put up additions and care for children. There are also short term jobs in industry and business during inventory time and plant clean-ups.

Brooks said his office is encouraging students to

take casual jobs since they provide some days of work this summer. Waiting for a full-time, summer-long job won't likely pay off.

"Students are willing to do just about any kind of work," Brooks observed.

He reported Student Manpower is receiving quite a few calls for workers this summer from Acton employers.

There are a number of farm orders and semi-industrial, service jobs here this summer for

students.

"It has been a little better (for student jobs) than we expected," Brooks said.

Manpower counsellors have been visiting Acton and area businesses and industry.
