Electrical hazards everywhere

"Electrical hazards such as the one that recently took a child's life are present in nearly every household" warns the Halton Hills Fire Department.

Overfusing, misusing of extension cords and unapproved wiring installations are the most common electrical faults found in the home.

Fuses act as a safety valve to permit only a specified amount of electricity to travel through the wiring in your house. Replacing a 15 amp fuse with a 25 or 30 amp fuse allows excessive electricity to pass at through ordinary lighting and receptacle circuits.

thus heating the wiring and causing a fire. Extension cords are often used where a permanently wired outlet should be. Extension cords should only be used for temporary electrical service. Extension cords with frayed wiring, insulation damage or with

appliance are particularly hazardous and should be replaced. The home handyman who doesn't have his work inspected by a professional electrician is likely to be the worst of offenders. Ontario Hydro will conduct an inspection of any electrical installations upon request, however there is a charge for this.

If an appliance is big or small, doesn't work right, don't use it, don't try to fix it—have it serviced.

If an appliance gets damp or wet, have it serviced before reuse.

Don't touch appliances if your shoes or hands are wet.

Turn off appliances before you go out.

Allow for air circulation around TV and stereo equipment.

Jelinek urges Trudeau Recall Parliament debate oil pricing

Halton MP Otto Jelinek wants Parliament recalled so the oil pricing issue can be debated.

Last week the Corporate Affairs critic sent a telegram to Prime Minister Pierre Trudeau urging "due to the unfortunate and potentially disastrous results of your all parts of Canada the inconclusive meetings opportunity to express

the views of their constituents regarding this serious issue with the view of achieving a Parliamentary consensus on the overall energy matter."
