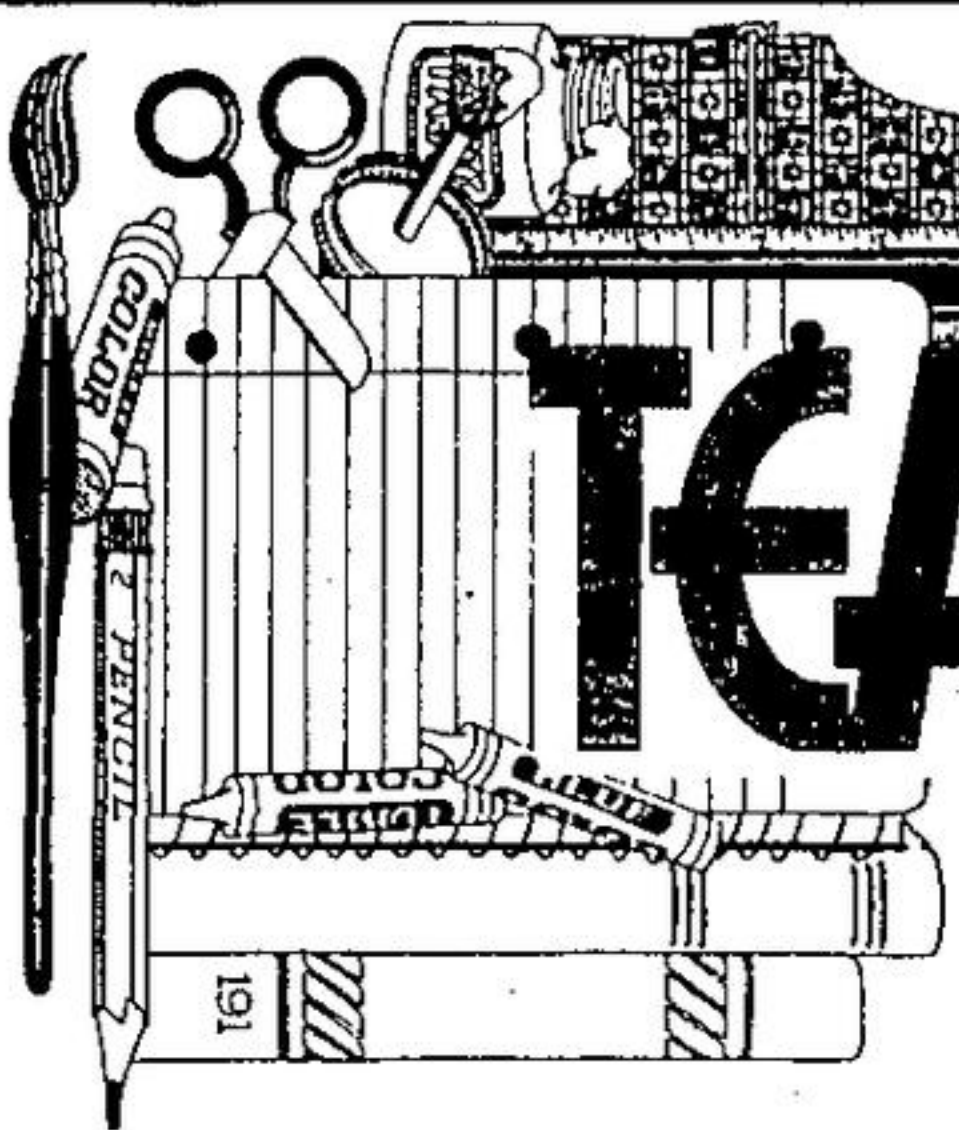
Immunization clinic

A community immunization clinic will be held next month at the Acton Community Services Centre.

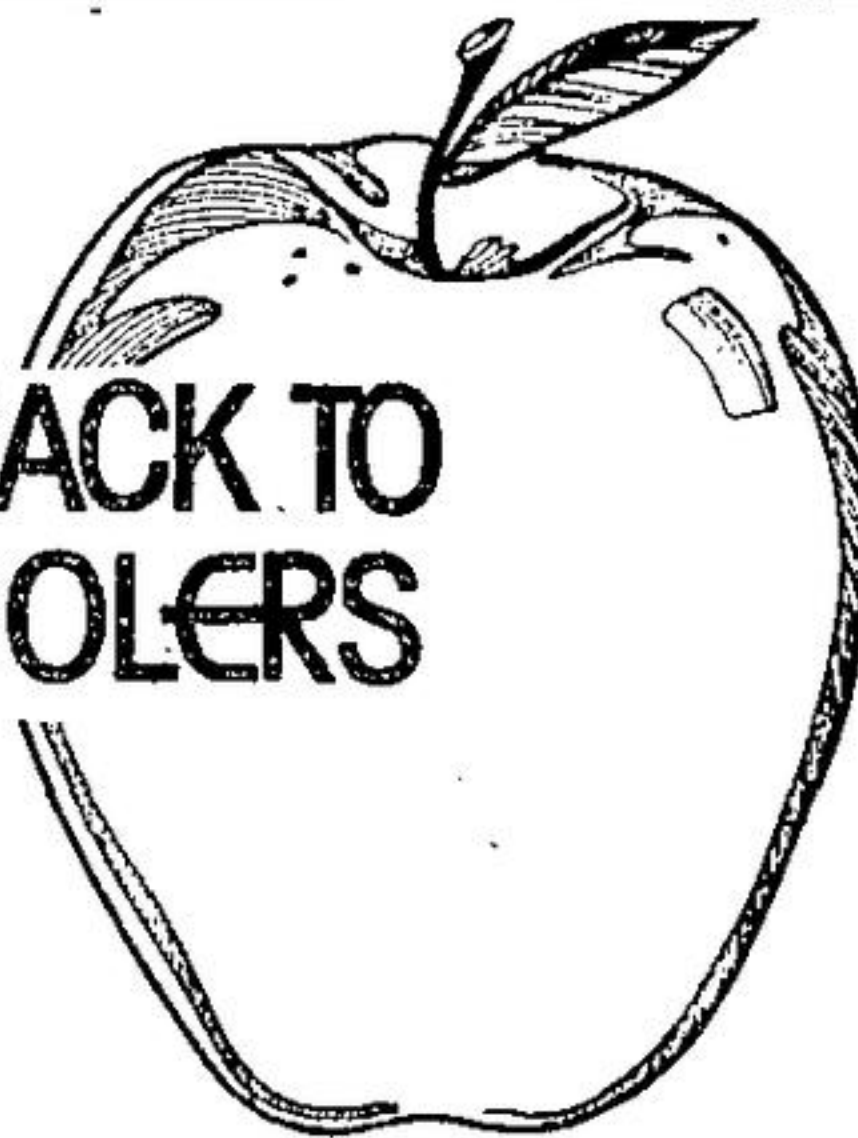
