SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS. 1. Exhibitors are required to mail their entries and fees to Mr. Glenn Williamson, R.R. 1, Acton, Ontario. L7J 2L7, prior to September 1st. 1980. Entry fees are \$4.00 per class, and stake classes are \$6.00. A membership of \$3.00 is required by the Acton Agricultural Society Post entries an additional \$2.00 per class. Post entries will be accepted until two (2) classes preceeding entered class.

All entries made by owner or authorized agent only, who are responsible for their own errors.

- 2. Horses to be registered with the Arabian Horse Registry of America, Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, International Arabian Horse Association, Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry or Registration Applied for, or if under one year of age, to be eligible for registration. Entries to be made under their full registered name and number and name of owner. Proof of registration or eligibility must be produced on request.
- 3. Registered Anglo-Arabians may cross enter into the Half-Arabian classes, following all rules and judged as the Half-Arabians.
- 4. A number will be assigned to each horse (Exhibitor in Junior classes) to be worn in the ring. Number to be returned prior to leaving the grounds.
- 5. Report to the Show Secretary upon arrival to secure all information and pick up number assigned to your horse. Riders and handlers must wear correct numbers.
- 6. We reserve the right to decline any entries and return entry fee without being liable to compensation, subject to C.E.F. Rules.
- 7. Any exhibitor refusing to show in the ring once he has entered any event shall forfeit the entry fee unless the horse has been excused by a veterinarian. A Vet certificate to be sent to the show Secretary postmarked no later than September 22nd, to be eligible for a refund.
- B. To enter stake classes, horses must be entered, shown and judged in at least one other class in that division.
- 9. No substitution of horses will be allowed after closing of entries. Any substitution will be considered a post entry and will be subject to post entry fees, each change on pre-entries will be considered a post entry. All post dated cheques will be considered as post entries and an additional \$2.00 per class will be charged before horse will be allowed to be judged.
- 10. All events will start on schedule. Exhibitors must have horses ready when called. Adequate time will be allowed for tack changes.
- 11. No interference or complaints to the judge by an exhibitor will be tolerated. All protests to the show committee must be made in writing in accordance with C.E.F. rules.
- 12. Only water available (no stabling or feeding facilities),
- 13. Food and refreshments are available on the grounds.
- 14. A \$3.00 membership fee will be deducted from winnings of over \$4.00 for 1981, membership. This fee will be charged once only in the case of an exhibitor winning or placing in more than one class. STARTING TIME: 10.00 a.m. sharp.
