More answers sought on senior housing

An extension has been granted to Eramosa Township's efforts to gather information concerning senior citizen housing.

Residents have until October 1 to finish the questionnaire.

As of Friday there were 47 responses received by the township's consultants Gibson-Bahynowski of Toronto. Most of them - 32 - expressed interest while 15 indicated no interest in senior housing.

The results, according to consultant Deirdre Gibson, follow a typical pattern.

Six of the 15 people not interested in such housing have incomes in excess of \$12,000 or \$13
