Further study of \$61,000 garbage bin

If Halton Hills wants a garbage bin at the old dump on Churchill Road South or the sewage treatment plant the town will likely have to foot the bill. Councillors agreed Monday night that there is little chance the region will pick up the tab.

A report from the region says operating and capital costs for a bin in Acton to reduce residential and rural area dumping would be about \$61,000.

Councillor Terry Grubbe proposed region and town staff study the matter of a garbage bin for Acton further. She noted the operation in Acton would be similar to Georgetown's three day a week service at the old dump so the cost effectiveness of the Georgetown operation should be reviewed. Grubbe would also like region and local staff to determine how many Acton and Esquesing residents take refuse to the Georgetown bin.

The town's request that the region spend \$61,000 for the bin and operation of the service will be reviewed when the region budget is struck next year.

Councillors may be liable for sewer surcharge deficit

Unless there is action today, current members of Halton Regional Council might be held legally liable for the sewer surcharge deficit, currently expected to be about \$500,000 by the end of the year.

Regional Solicitor and Acting Chief Administrative Officer Dennis Perlin has scheduled a noon-hour meeting today at which he will advise councillors to make a major hike in the sewer and water rates.

The hike which, if approved later today at Council, would take effect Jan. 1, 1981, and would be high enough to balance the books on the sewer surcharge deficit during calendar year 1981.

Mr. Perlin has stated that the Intergovernmental Affairs Ministry considers a regional government operating with deficit financing to be illegal.

Therefore, he said the current council, which brought in the sewer surcharge on Jan. 1 of this year

must make "a reasonable effort" to make good the deficit.

If that reasonable effort is not made, Mr. Perlin said the current council, particularly those who will not be returning due to election losses, might face lawsuits.

Today is the last regular Regional Council meeting and therefore the last chance the council has of making the reasonable effort.

"This council must do something... to show it has taken all action it could possibly take," Mr. Perlin said.
