**Twp. trailer bylaw tussle**

Eramosa Township Council will be taking another look at the enforcement of its house trailer bylaw in the face of a Rockwood man's "violation."  
The old council gave building inspector John Salmon a green light to enforce the bylaw, however, he indicates he will approach the new council for reconsideration.  
The trailer in question is one on Lou Hills' car lot in the village.  
Salmon told Hills that if he did not agree with the township's stand against the use of trailers, then he should write council.  
Hills disagrees with council that the trailer is a violation of bylaws and that the use of it as a temporary office is not permitted.  
Hills' letter reads in part: "I do not agree. Being in the automotive sales industry, the unit in question is part of that industry. In fact the unit in question is there for demonstration purposes. It is offered for sale as part of the normal retail automotive business."  
The letter went on to state: "It should be noted, this is not the first trailer unit we have offered for sale in fact we have sold several of these in the past months, most recently being two weeks ago."  
Dave Masson, as deputy-reeve, said that there appears to be some pre-cast stairs and railing in front of the trailer. "It appears to be a violation."  
There have been a number of trailer bylaw violations in the past few months.
