

Women's Place open and operating

During its first two weeks of operation, Halton Women's Place has provided temporary emergency shelter for seven women and their families, according to Director Loretta Costigane. Costigane said of the seven families, two remain at the hostel while five others have left to live with family or return to their husbands. The temporary home for abused women and their family, located in Milton, is equipped to house 18 women and their children. Donations of clothing, toys and other goods were overwhelming,

However, the centre is still in need of baby supplies, and infant furniture. Blankets for the beds in the adult rooms are also needed.

Halton Women's Place offers abused women a temporary home, with 24 hour staff to counsel and help in finding a home

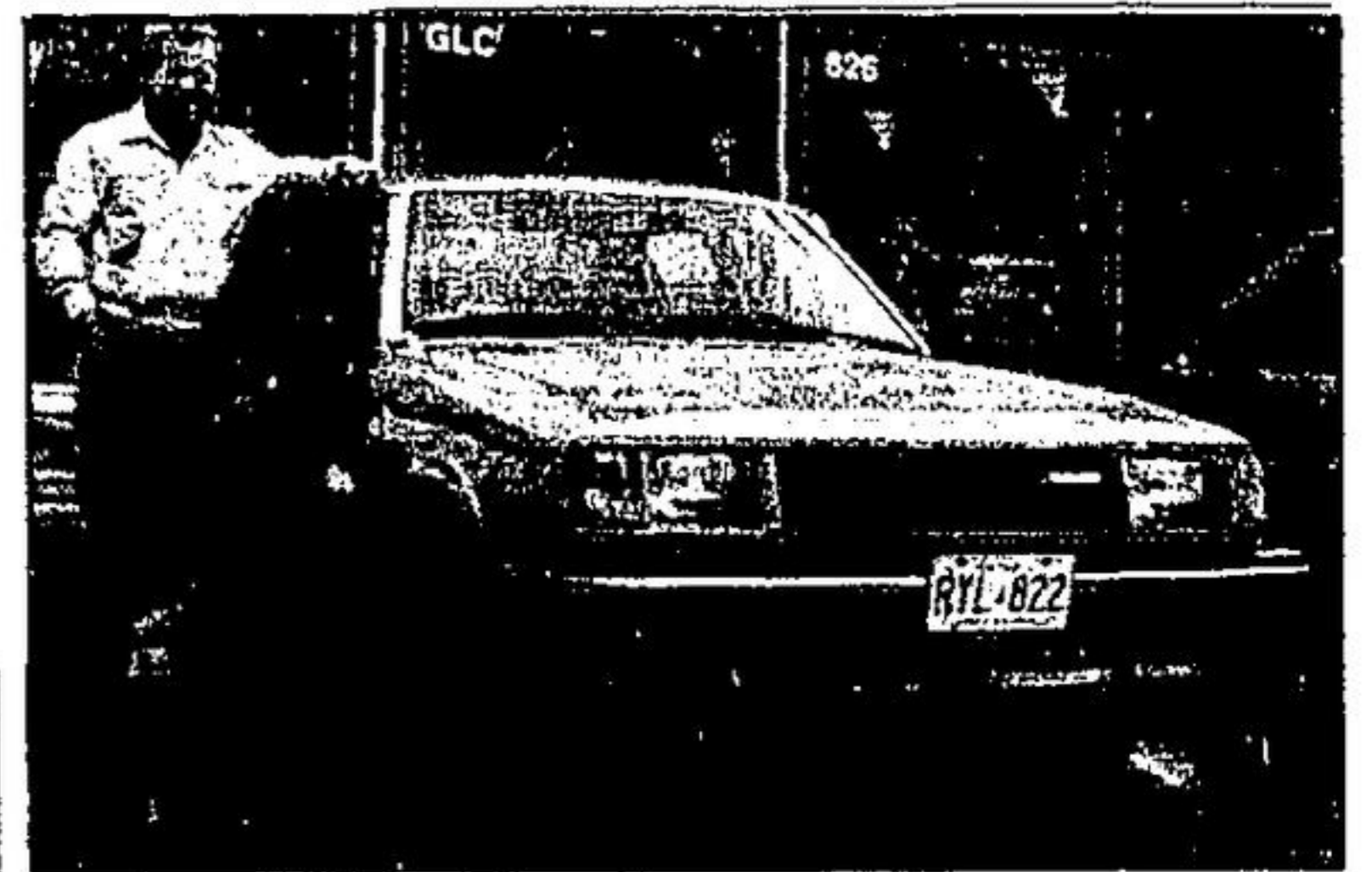

The Mazda 626

Free Press test drives

Mazda 626

Mazda advertises its new 626 car as one that "hugs the road like a sports car, rides like a full-size car, looks like a European road car and saves money like an economy car."

A recent road test around town confirms most of these impressions. Les Pellett, owner of Achilles Motors, lent his own Mazda 626 Sports Sedan for an hour or so for the test.

The instruments on the dash of the Mazda 626 are set directly in front of the driver. The speedometer is easy to read. There are large letters for kilometers and smaller ones for miles.

The seats are of light blue corduroy. There is also grey trim and arm rests—all of which match the blue exterior finish. The front seats are comfortable and there is ample leg room for the

driver. The rear seats fold down to expose the trunk. The seats latch at the top.

Within easy reach of the driver are the controls which adjust the side mirrors and open and close the sun roof. All controls are electric.

The 626 dash features four air vents: two each for the driver and passenger. The driver also gets a glove compartment on his side of the car in addition to the traditional compartment.

The exterior of the machine is well finished. The panels fit snugly together.

Behind the wheel, the seat belts are easy to reach and lock and unlock at a touch.

There was not enough time to check how much it costs to run the Mazda 626. The advertisement claims 54 km per Imperial gallon. That works out

to be slightly more than 30 miles per gallon.

On the road the Sports Sedan proved to be an easy to handle machine. It passed other cars without too much effort. On Highway 25 and 24 and in town the Mazda 626 proved itself a comfortable vehicle.

Along the town line the 626 Sedan retains the feel of the road.

The 1970 cc engine starts readily and idles quietly. Acceleration with the automatic transmission from a standing start to 50 miles per hour seemed to take a while. The advertisement states the 626 can reach 50 miles per hour (80 kph) in 9.8 seconds.

Once on the road, however, the Mazda 626 is an easy to direct responsive machine.

The 626 Sport Sedan and Sport Coupe have more than 30 standard features including five-speed manual transmission, automatic choke, tinted glass, full length protective body-side mouldings, electric remote trunklid release and on and on!

The 626 Sport Sedan can be bought for \$7,995.

Lynx

Mercury's new Lynx, the latest North American entry into the sub-compact field, fits right in with imported front-wheel drive machines.

The Mercury Lynx and Ford's Escort are going to give foreign manufacturers a run for customer's dollars.

L and L Ford lent one of the Lynx for a test drive around town and country.

Overall the three-door hatchback appeared to be a solidly constructed vehicle with a peppery 1.6 litre four-cylinder power plant.

There is a sister line of Fords, built in Europe, which are mainly the same as the North American version except for the engine.

Only in North America you say? That's right. Only here can customers get the new Compound Valve Hemispherical engine. Ford spent, it claims, \$1-billion developing the hemispherical shaped heads and combustion chambers.

Transport Canada rates the new engine at 5.3 litres per 100 kilometres, or 53 miles per gallon on the highway and less on city and highway driving.

The L and L Ford machine was of a dark brown color, with a coffee brown interior. The seats were plastic, however, comfortable.

On the road the Lynx moved right along well with traffic. The shifting was smooth and accurate.

The AM-FM radio gave a rich sound which was not drowned out by the sound of the engine or traffic.

The Mercury Lynx hatchback is selling for \$7,262.30.

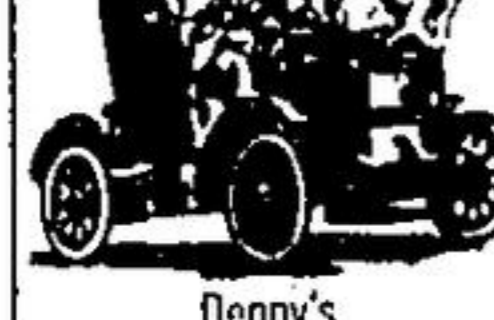

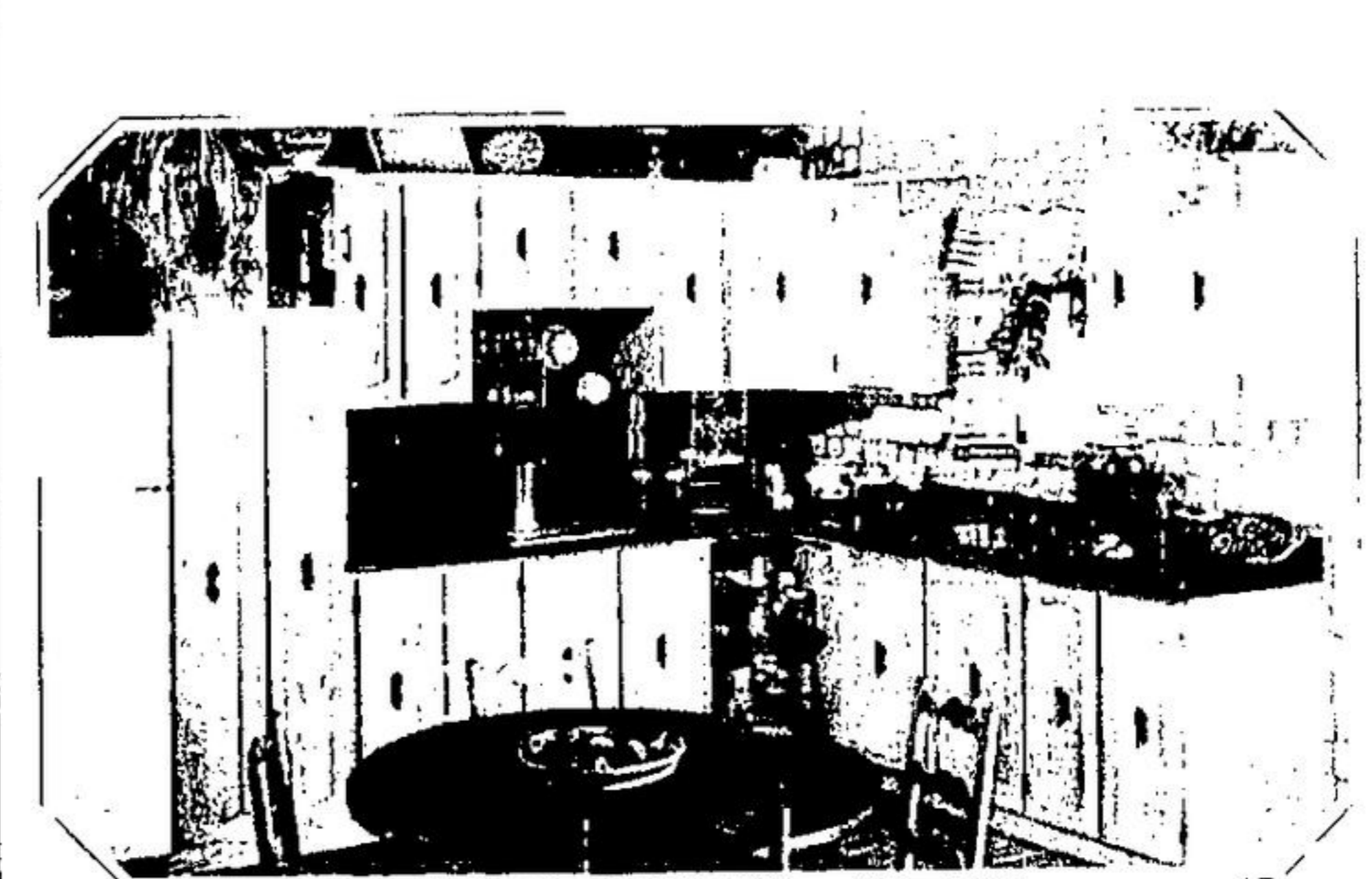
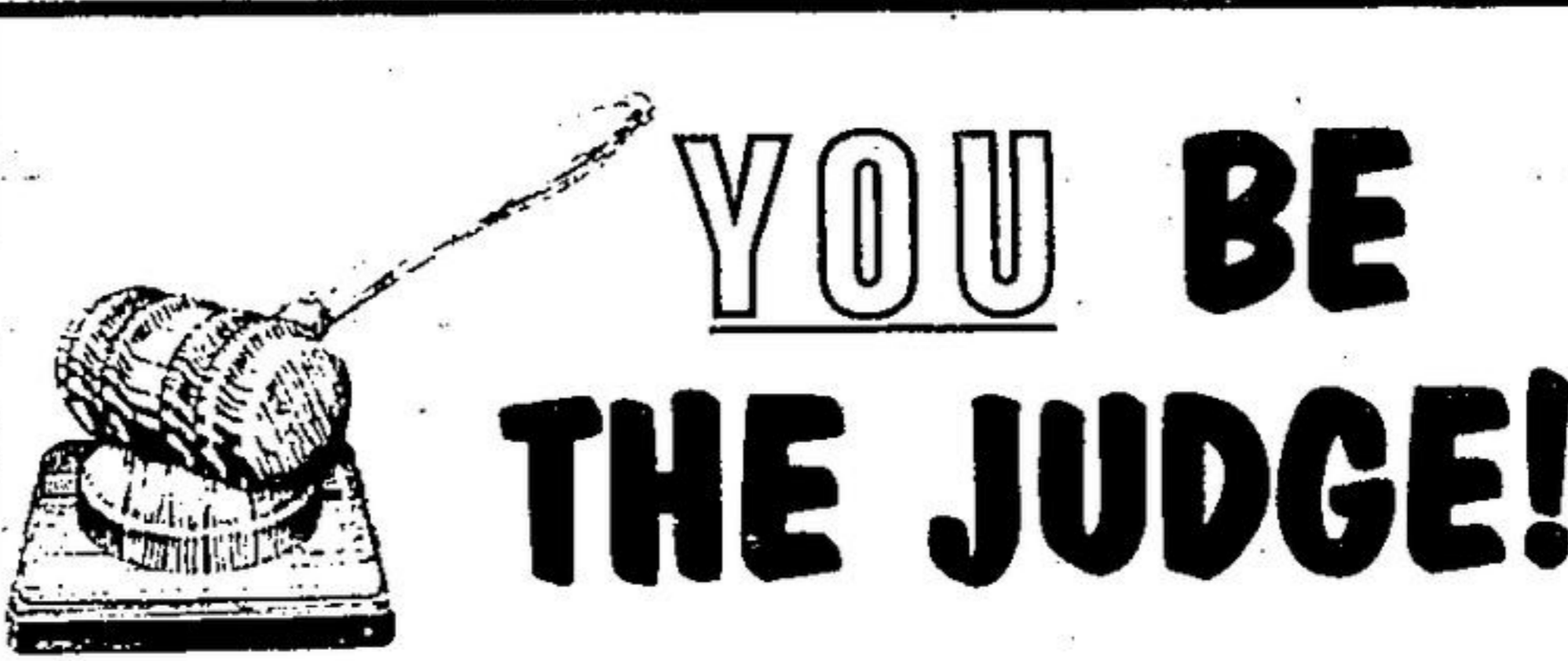
