Bateman is a painter with a statement that comes from his years of experience in the field. Bateman feels that by being portrayed as a wildlife artist, he is known merely as an illustrator and not as a true artist. He is sensitive about that, because as a child, he began his artistic endeavors as an illustrator.

Bateman is a former Rockwood aren resident and now lives in north Nassagaweya.

Bateman, 50, feels he has come a long way and wants this recognized. He says it's not easy.

"I want to be known as an artist with a capital 'A', but there is a plot against those who do wildlife. They're labelled as illustrators, a lower form of artist," he says. Bateman claims that

wildlife artists rarely achieve the honor of having their work hung in a gallery, a claim to which he will personally attest. The reaction of a Swedish gallery about the impressions his wildlike creations evoked struck Bateman.

"I visited a state museum there and they loved my work," he told his audience. "Unfortunately they said they didn't have it in their budget to include my work in their museum of

history. natural 'Museum?' I said, 'why not use my work in your art gallery?' That's the kind of thing I have to put up with."

When asked to be a guest speaker, Bateman is more often invited by a naturalists group than artists. influences

Outside Baleman's shaped personal approach to art. It started when he was a child, drawing pictures of animals.

"I had a log on which I drew pictures of owls-1 had a picture of every kind of owl in North America!" he laughed. The critical opinion of a

friend encouraged him to take a closer look at his work as a teenager. Bateman realized that he was in fact drawing, not creating. This is where the outside influences took effect, and his art began to lean towards the Impressionobstract. alism became his style.

At this point in his career, Bateman has become opposed to detail in his work, and instead

tries to get an impression on canvas as quickly as possible, capturing the essence of his subject easily, in a few seconds. The result is a vibrant rhythmic distorted yet discernable.

Though has changed completely over the years, his subject content is still the same. He is a wildlife artist, with a capital 'A'.
