at the Tillsonburg town police office since last week. Ontario Provincial Police charged four members of the Tillsonburg force-including the chief and deputy chiefwith a number of criminal offences.

Cpl. Arbour was in charge of the Acton OPP station until the fall of when Halton Regional Police took over law enforcement.




