Former Halton Treasurer finds new region job

Interviewed on Wednesday, Mr. Farmer, a long-time Burlington resident, said he will start his new job with Haldimand-Norfolk on May 19.

When he resigned last August, he indicated that he wanted to remain with Halton in a managerial position but afterwards chose not to apply to become manager of systems for the region.

A confidential draft study done by management consultants and obtained by this newspaper in January recommended against Mr. Farmer being offered a job by the region.

The report also said a lack of staff and an increased workload in Halton's treasury department were responsible for errors leading to last year's deficit.

Several regional councillors subsequently said Mr. Farmer had been made a "scapegoat" for the embarrassing situation which has caused many local residents to lose confidence in the regional government.
