**Joe Scott gets gold at YOU Canadian Games**

Local athletes earn recognition for their efforts in track and field in their school and community but there are more and more track meets today open to individuals with special interests or handicaps.

One of those young men with a special interest is 20 year old Joe Scott of Limehouse. Joe has just recently returned from Regina where he competed for Ontario at the Youth Opportunity United (YOU) Canadian Track and Field Championships.

The YOU Championships are open to members of the World Wide Church of God members of which Joe is a part. Their meet is held much in the same way as the Canadian Championships with all com-

petitors qualifying at a regional or provincial meet for the right to move on to the Canadians.

Scott competed against 150 other athletes from the Ontario area in an effort to become one of 44 Ontarian athletes to compete in Regina and his efforts were rewarded with placement in four events at the Canadians including discus, high jump, 110 metre hurdles and the four by 100 metre relay team.

Joe helped Ontario to a first place overall standing in the competition and a top placing in the senior boys category. Strong in the discus, Joe took a gold medal at the Games in that event with a throw of 37.29 metres or 122 feet, 3/4 inches., a personal best. In addition Joe picked up a second gold as a member of the relay team which set a new YOU record of 45.9, breaking the existing mark of 46.1 set last year by Joe and three teammates at the Canadians.

A pair of silver medals picked up with a second in high jump with a leap of 1.72 metres or 5 feet, six inches, coupled with an 18 second 110 metre high hurdle rounded out Joe's medal efforts.

"The meets are fun," says Joe, "it's true competition." Joe feels that those competing at the meet are not out to outdo their opposition as much as they are looking for a new personal best.

"The medals are nice," stated Joe, "but I was more disappointed that I couldn't attain a personal best in the high jump."

If Joe's attitude holds true he cannot be totally disappointed with his western trip as he picked up two personal bests—the discus and the hurdles along with helping set a new YOU record in the relay.

The son of Spike and Doris Scott, Joe is currently hoping to attend the Church College, Ambassador College, in Pasadena, California, in the future. In the meantime the Georgetown High school graduate is working at Varian.
