Separate teachers, board bargaining

Members of the Halton Separate School Board and the negotiating team for the 425 teachers are once again at the bargaining table working on a contract for 1981-'82. The present teaching contract expires September 1.

William Hawken, negotiations chairman for the board, says he will be meeting with the teachers' chief negotiator Elizabeth Vasas and members of the teachers' team Wednesday (today) to further discuss the issues. Meetings have

been few during the summer with the absence of members from both sides for holidays. Hawken refused to comment on the contract negotiations or to disclose details of the teachers' requests or board's offer at this time.

"We are negotiating in good faith and I'm not releasing any details at this point," Hawken said.

Last year's contract was signed almost two months after the September 1 expiry date. The teachers, who originally

asked for a 22 per cent increase and were offered seven per cent, voted 72 per cent to accept the final offer giving them a 9.5 per cent wage increase for the 1980-81 school year, plus increments valued at 2.5 per cent last year.

The agreement reached last year cost the board \$10,200,263. Elizabeth Vasas headed the teacher negotiating committee last year while former Georgetown trustee Hartley Sherk acted as negotiations chairman for the board.

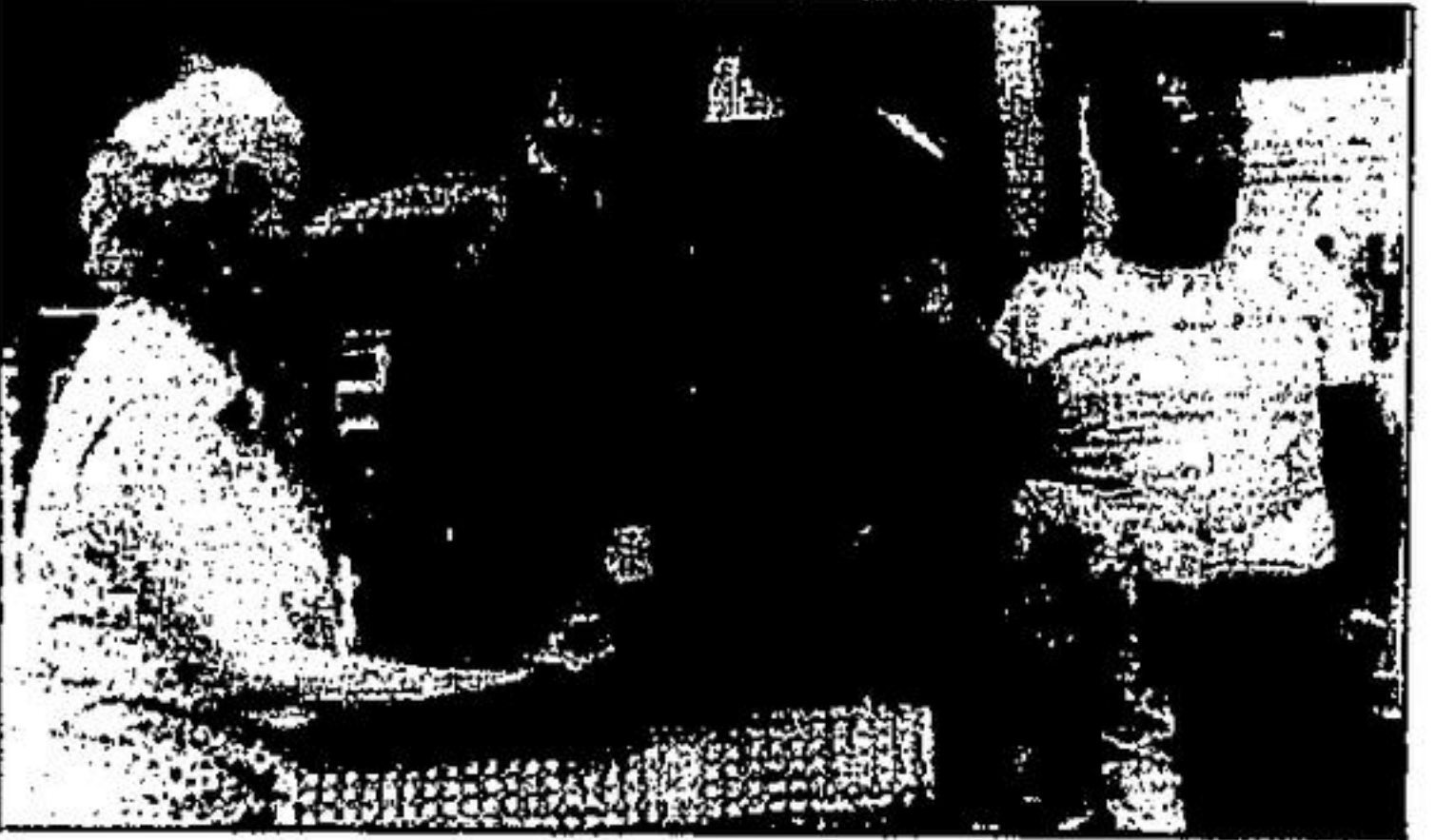
