the department and reason for the study, are vague as in most cases. Crews were out for six hours Monday, and six hours Tuesday. As many vehicles as

possible are stopped and asked such questions as where they are going, where they are coming from, and how often they make that trip. About one to one and a half · minutes of the drivers' time is taken up, and no one is obligated to answer the questions. Exact addresses are requested because the province is divided up into small squares and trips are pinpointed. Names are not taken, and nobody is stopped more than

The amount of people stopped depends on the weather, Cook said. 1 They do not go out in inclement weather, and their part of the study usually lasts from April to September. That way university and college students can be hired to do the job. The number of those stopping traffic

depends on the locality. The surveyers usually stay in hotels or motels close to their project. That way, Cook said, ocal restaurants and benefit of their business

Crews travel across the province doing these studies, which Cook sald essentially helps plan the future of the roads. Exact reasons various projects are not given.


