Single horse ladies open draw, heavy or light:
 1st ... \$50. 2nd ... \$40. 3rd ... \$30. 4th ... \$20.
 \$10 to all remaining entrants, making a qualifying draw.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All entries must register one hour (1) prior to the start of the event.
2. Course to be (20) twenty feet long. Sidelines to be (20) twenty feet apart, and a qualifying draw to be a minimum of (20) twenty feet.
3. There will be no pass up of draw
4. There will be three tries to draw the load (20) twenty feet. Horses must stay within the sidelines.
5. A harness break will be allowed 5 minutes to be repaired or the discretion of the judge.
6. Teamster and two helpers allowed with each team.
7. While hitching to the boat, no teamster or helpers are allowed to head the team.
8. Helpers are not allowed to talk to the horses while hitching to the boat.
9. In case of slashing or whipping or the use of profanity, this will constitute disqualification.
10. Teamster or helpers are not allowed to talk to the judge.
11. Any forward movement of the boat will be counted as a draw.
12. From when the Teamster enters the draw area, he will have three minutes only to hitch his team.
13. The Committee reserves the right to do a saliva and/or urinalysis test on any team entered in either the light or heavy pull.

Rules

Ponies must be hitched to a suitable vehicle to be judged on manners, quality and performance, proof of age must be shown in classes where there is an age limit.

Sections

1. Showmanship of pony under 50 inches open to a boy or girl 15 years or under, 60% for showmanship, 40% for animal. No entry fee required.

Sponsored by Shortill's Tack Shop, Ballinafad. \$8 \$6 \$3 for all remaining entries.

2. Shetland Pony 44 in. and under, over 2 years on the line. \$15 \$12 \$10 \$8

3. Hackney pony over 44 in. and under 50 in. on the line. \$15 \$12 \$10 \$8. Sponsored by Ziegler Flour Mill Ltd. Acton.

4. Hackney Cobtail over 50 in. and under 14.2 on the line. \$15 \$12 \$10 \$8. Sponsored by Desmonds Farm & Feed Supply, 1 mile south of Acton on Hwy. 25.

5. Team of harness ponies 44 in. and under 50 in. \$30 \$28 \$25 \$20.

13. Single pony 50 in. and under driven by a boy or girl under 16 years, open to Halton County, Erin and Eramosa Townships. \$15 and the Bank of Nova Scotia Trophy, \$12 \$10 \$8 to the remainder.

14. Roadster pony 50 in. and under, driver must wear colours. Hitched to a sulky to be judged on speed and conformation. Sponsored by United Co-Operatives of Ontario, Georgetown Farm and Home Centre. \$25 \$22 \$20 \$18.

15. Group of three ponies under 14.2 hands. Owned by one exhibitor. \$15 \$12 \$10 \$8 \$6.
