Weighing in time 3.00 p.m. on portable scales in the fairgrounds.

**RULES FOR
ANTIQUE AND OUT-OF-FIELD TRACTOR CLASSES**

Antique and Out-of-field Tractor pull classes shall be governed by rules set forth by the C.M.T.P.A. as follows:—

ANTIQUE CLASS

Shall be any original tractor 1950 and prior, weighing 5000 pounds or under—7000 pounds or under without added weights or ballast. No steel lugs.

Entrant tractor may enter one class only.

Draw bar to be of standard height or original tractor entered.

Under/over weight allding measurement

Tractors over class weight entered will have one (1) foot of pull distance deducted per 100 pounds of overweight. Tractors underweight in the class will have one (1) foot added to pull distance per 100 pounds of underweight.

OUT-OF-FIELD

Shall be any working farm tractor "as is" weighing 5000 pounds or under 7000 pounds or under without added weight or ballast.

Entrant may enter one class only.

Draw bar to be of standard height of original tractor.

Under/over weight allding measurement

same as determined for Antique class.

GENERAL RULES

1. No one allowed on track except for officials and drivers.
2. Tractors must be operated in a safe manner.
3. Driver must be seated during pull.
4. No passengers
5. All tractors must stop immediately upon signal from Judge. The pull shall be considered over when forward motion of the load stops.
6. No drinking at track.
7. During hitching and unhitching tractors must be in neutral or park.
8. Violation of any rule will result in disqualification.
9. Each tractor will pull according to its own weight.
10. Rules for contest will be available on day of the pull.

6. Work boots only, no cleats or hobnails
