OUT-OF-FIELD

Shall be any working farm tractor "as is" weighing 5000 pounds or under 7000 pounds or under without added weight or ballast. Entrant may enter one class only.

Draw bar to be of standard height of original tractor.

GENERAL RULES

- Tractors must be operated in a safe manner.
