### RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Fiddlers time limits: not more than 3 minutes, however there will be no penalty for playing over the limit.
2. Registration between 3.00 p.m. and 5.00 p.m. and the contest will start at 5.00 p.m. sharp. Entry forms premailed to assist in the program development would be appreciated.
3. Contestants must play a waltz, jig, and a reel or hornpipe.
4. Tunes must be accepted Old Tyme Types.
5. Players may have one accompanist, a piano and pianist will be supplied for the use of the players.
6. Accompanist may chord or play melody, accompanist may be supplied by the player.
7. In case of an accident beyond player's control (broken string), power failure or Act of God, he or she may replay.
8. The judges will award points on the following: Time, Tempo—must be suitable dance style, Tone, Style, and Technique, Overall accuracy.
9. Two calls per fiddlers to come to playing competition.
10. Judges' decisions are final.
11. Duet open to all contestants: may be mixed (men-women) and no age limit.
12. Duet prize money will be split between contestants.
13. Contestants may register for one class only, plus the duet and the step dance.
14. Pre-registration required by mail.
