**OBJECTIVES**

1. To create greater interest among young people in caring for, feeding, developing and marketing of cattle and in the production and marketing of milk and milk products.

**PROJECTS**

1. To feed and care for one calf for the duration of the club year.
2. To study recommended practices of feeding and management and keep records of the cost of production.

**BASIS OF AWARDS**

- (a) 200 points for showmanship at Achievement Day
- (b) 100 points each for attendance at meetings, Quiz, Farm Visit.
- (c) 150 points for exhibit add 125 points for Judging, 125 points for Club Reporting
- (d) 50 points for special project.
