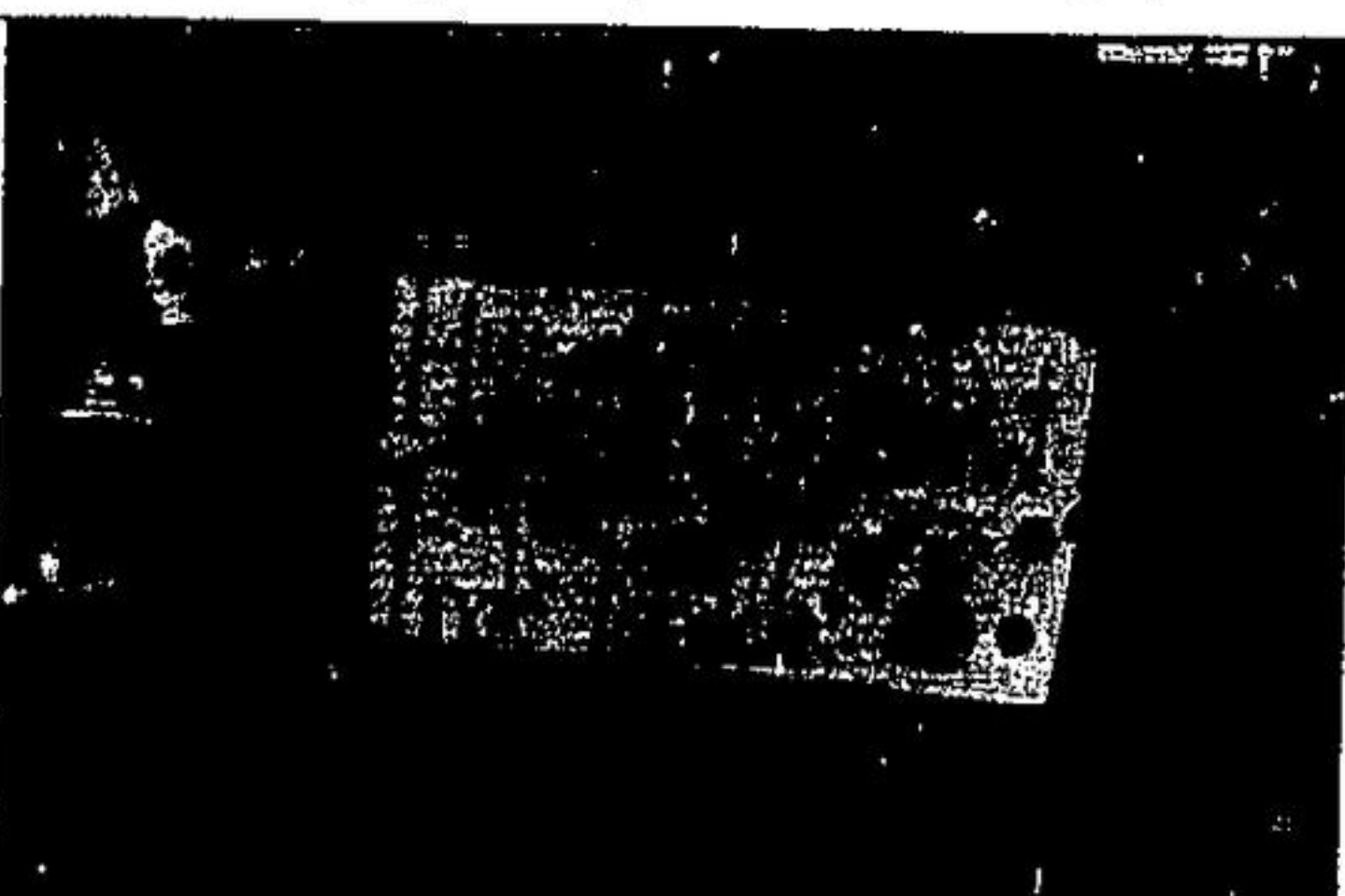
Playground finale 1981
