French Immersion is for all students-board

French Immersion is not just for the bright students but for all who can handle the environment, about 30 interested parents learned Monday evening at Robert Little School.

The parents were on hand to hear Peter Spencer one of the French consultants for the Halton Board of Education tell them about the program, which is now in its first year in Acton.

There are two entry points into the program in Halton, he explained, grade one and grade six. Spencer explained the local board does not offer the program in kindergarten because officials feel the child has enough new experiences to cope with without having to hear a foreign language every day. Also, he said, for many students in Halton, English is a second language and the board gives the kindergarten students a year to get used to the English all around them.

It is again offered at the grade six level for those whose parents felt the child could not cope with at the lower grade, who now need a challenge.

Halton has chosen the 50/50 ratio for classes in both English and French. In grade one, the early program (grades one to five) subjects taught in English are art, English language, and math. In French students learn French, environmental studies, music, and physical and health education.

In the senior portion of the program English, art, industrial arts, family studies, music, science and physical

health education are in English. In French are Math, French and Social Science. Spencer pointed out more programs are taught in English in the later grades because the courses are taught by specialists who do not necessarily know the French language.

Once in high school, students may continue to take the French Immersion, in such subjects as Canadian studies, geography and history.

There are currently 32 students in the French Immersion grade 1 class at Robert Little, the only such class in Acton. However, Spencer said, if enough parents are interested to form another grade it can be done.

Transportation to the special classes is up to the parents. Spencer explained if a child went to kindergarten at Robert Little, and was a bus student, he or she would continue to be bused to school for grade one. However, a child previously attending M.Z. Bennett would not be bused to Robert Little.

French Immersion teachers must go through a series of schooling and interviews before even being considered to teach in a Halton School. Spencer noted they must first achieve their teachers' certificate, then a French teaching certificate, and then go through several French language interviews by the board to assure their proficiency in the language.

Students in the program must really want to be there and

must have good attendance records, as it is harder to catch up after missing some school.

Spencer stressed a child in his first year of French Immersion should not be put into any extracurricular activities for the first time either. He explained the student will be using all his or her concentration and energies in learning the French and will have no energy to be taking figure skating or piano lessons.

Parents at Monday's meeting were concerned with the high pupil-teacher ratio, as compared to a regular class. In French Immersion, Spencer had pointed out it was 32-1, while in the regular class the PTR was only about 25-1. He explained the ratio is high because child may drop out and they still need enough in the class in order to have one.

While grade one will always be a separate class, if necessary, grades two and three or three and four may be combined, in order to have enough students to keep the program going. The board is taking into consideration the lower kindergarten registration this year and will adjust their ratio accordingly.

Registration is taken on a first come first served basis. Priority is not given to residents of Acton, or students of Robert Little School. Spencer noted dates and even times are written on the forms to ensure the first people to register are the first choice.

Parents also had a chance to speak informally with Robert Little program teacher Peggy Corner.

some signs to direct the tourist business to the site.

Restoration of the building to its original condition does not seem practical. The costs would be astronomical and, as indicated in the previous paragraph, the mood or appearance of the original building cannot likely be restored due to the renovations already made on the interior and due to the small lot and the abutting fire hall. Again the costs would be prohibitive.

"We would further point out that demolition of the town hall would provide for construction of some new structure which may be complementary to the existing fire hall and second floor assembly hall and construction of something to replace the town hall is almost required since the side of the fire hall now adjacent to the town hall may look somewhat odd."
