

(Continued from page 1) Foster agrees with pundits who believe Hae's election as leader puts the party back to the same level of strength it attained in the '75 election when New Democrats won the Official Opposition. When the new leader's capabilities are fully known across

the province Foster says he can "guarantee" polls show he's viewed by all voters as Ontario's "most competent leader." He compares Rae favorably with former leader Stephen Lewis who was highly regarded by voters of all policital stripes and naturally far above Michael Cassidy, whose election as leader Foster always regarded as a mistake. He preferred runner-up Ian Deans, who is much like Rae. Rae's advantage over Lewis in terms of being able to lead the NDP to power is he is younger and viewed as

more moderate. "He's (Rae) a bright new star and the Tories are in the later stages of senility as a government. Another convention highlight was the election of his candidate for party president, Marion Chambers of Erin who carried the NDP banner, in
