The Free Press reported on May 11, 1977 that a petition with 2,000 signatures was presented to Council asking to have the Town Hall saved. There were reportedly over 100 people in the council chamber. Acton Free Press

On October 18 (1977), Council appointed a 'Special Building Committee' to investigate the possible historical designation of the Old Town Hall in Acton. This special committee reported back to Council (December, 1977) with the recommendation that the former Acton Town Hall was of historical value and interest. Council enacted a by-law (77-94) to designate the former Acton Town Hall as an historical site.




