Heller's go to four days next month

Heller's expects to go on work sharing the first week of September. Spokesman Fred Dawkins explained the firm will go to a four day work week for at least two weeks and then assess the situation. Heller's applied for work sharing back in May, around the same time as Beardmore, but they were approved under the 26 week program. Beardmore's application was in the works when the government program was changed to 20 weeks and they had to re-apply. Heller's was approved July 7 for the program which pays 60 per cent of workers' wages for days they are off, but Dawkins noted they weren't informed until just before their summer shut-down. The company couldn't review the program and situation until earlier this month. After the first two weeks on work sharing the situation will be reviewed. Dawkins said they can go to a five day week or three day week, it all depends on business. One hundred Heller's workers will be under work sharing.
