Jelinek urges govt. to hold 6-5

The Progressive Conservative Automotive spokesman, Otto Jelinek, M.P. (Halton), called on Prime Minister Trudeau to use his office to assure that current wage demands by the United Auto Workers Union be held within the six and five percent guidelines established in Parliament.

The P.C. Automotive Spokesman observed that the automotive industry will be put in a double bind if the UAW does not agree to settle for significantly lower wage demands. "On one hand," he says, "the Government is trying to stimulate domestic automotive production by introducing protectionist auto import policies." "On the other hand," he continues, "the UAW is trying to throttle the industry by demanding a 14 per cent increase."

Jelinek was commenting on the UAW's current demands for approximately a 14 per cent increase over each year of a new three year contract. The Union is currently negotiating with Ford and G.M. and has taken a strike vote which would put workers in a legal position to strike after September 14 at either Ford or GM.

Meanwhile, Canadian Labour Congress president Dennis McDermott has assailed the federal Liberal government's economic policy in his annual Labor Day message.

In a letter delivered to the Prime Minister, Jelinek added that, "It is quite obvious that if the UAW continues to press for these unrealistic wage demands the Canadian Auto Industry will fold." "UAW members," he continued, "would not only be limited to a six and five percent wage increase, they will be out of a job totally if the Union sticks to its current demands."

"One out of every six Canadians in the work force is out of work. Artificially high interest rates and unnecessarily high energy prices keep pushing the cost of living ever higher. As a result many Canadians have lost their homes because they cannot keep up with their mortgages," McDermott said. "For young people, without any prospects for a decent job, buying a home has become an unattainable dream."

With their purchasing power constantly shrinking, people are unable to make large purchases and must keep all their expenditures to a minimum. This in turn hurts business and industry and completes the vicious circle, putting even more people out of work.

"And to top it all off, it has gone on a rampage against people's incomes by imposing its so-called 6 and 5 per cent solution on 500,000 federal government employees and staff of crown corporations, and by promoting the imposition of similar 'solutions' on workers in the provincial and private sectors."

"In effect, the government is doing the exact opposite of what needs to be done to lift Canada out of its economic crisis; it reduces consumer incomes and increases the cost of living these consumers have to face—the perfect recipe for even worse inflation and unemployment."

MUNICIPAL ENUMERATION

Starting September 7, 1982, an enumerator, carrying a proper identification card, will call at your residence for a few minutes to check basic information required in determining:

- your eligibility to vote in the municipal and school board elections to be held on November 8 this year;
- the allocation of education property taxes between the public and separate school systems;
- the distribution of provincial grants to local governments to help reduce tax bills;
- the preparation of jurors' lists; and
- population information needed for other municipal programs.

The enumerator must record such information as the name, age, property status (e.g. owner or tenant), school support and residency of all members of the household.

This year in certain areas the enumerator will also ask if you would like your name included on a list of electors for French-language schools.

When the enumerator visits, please check that the information on the Enumeration Notice is correct. If it is not, revise it and verify the changes.

If you are not home, a Notice will be left for you. If changes are necessary, please make them and mail the Enumeration Notice, as soon as possible, in the pre-addressed postage prepaid envelope accompanying the Notice. For any additional information, please contact the local assessment office.
