Jelinek urges govt. to hold 6-5

Jelinek added that, "It is quite obvious that if the UAW continues to unrealistic demands the Canadian Industry "UAW memhe continued, only be limited to a six and five percent wage increase, they will be out of a job totally if the Union sticks to its current demands."

Spokesman observed that the automotive industry will be put in a double bind if the UAW does not agree to settle for significantly lower wage demands. "On one hand," he says, "the Government is trying to stimulate domestic automotive production by introducing protectionist auto import policies." "On the other band." he continues. 
