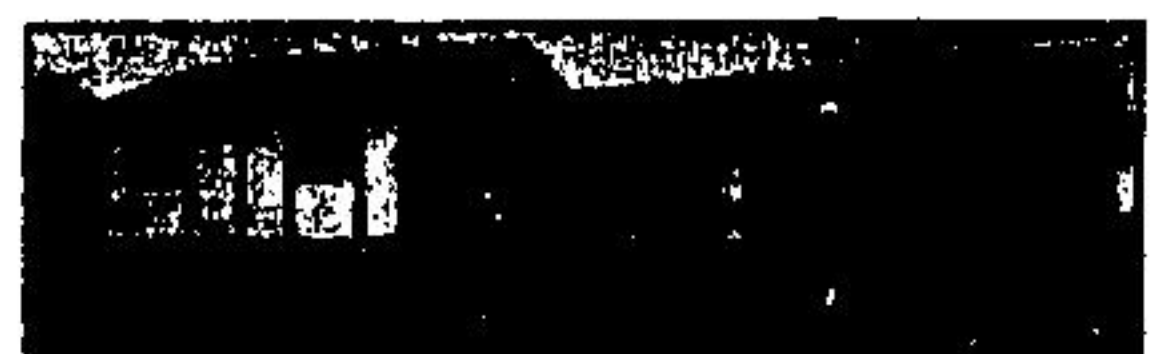

Bodies at jail can't be found

It appears the two men hanged at Milton jail more than 100 years ago will rest in eternal peace as their whereabouts continue to elude archeologist Roberta O'Brien.

A reconstruction project at the old court house and jail complex on Brown St. necessitated an initial dig a month ago when it was thought the graves might be disturbed while creating a basement in an area of the building. Excavations at the site, which would have been affected by the underpinning, proved fruitless.

Results of that dig conducted in July intrigued the archeologist, however, and she returned last week to further investigate an old foundation which seems to run into the existing western wall of the jail courtyard.

Prior to continuing the dig in this area, she and her crew took one last stab at locating the bodies, following yet another lead from a local witcher. That location, in the rear courtyard, revealed no clues of the illusive bodies.

It had been planned to relocate the bodies in an established cemetery.

Rural service extended

In reaction to concerns expressed by Canada Post Corporation customers, rural route delivery service on Saturdays has been extended to the end of September.

The final Saturday of rural route service will be September 25.

Canada Post Corporation president Michael Warren directed the extension because of concerns expressed about the timing of the change and its effect on newspapers in rural areas.

"We made a commitment to our customer to provide reasonable notice and two weeks is not satisfactory to allow those affected to make alternative delivery arrangements. Therefore implementation of five-day delivery on rural routes will be delayed until October, giving our customers six weeks to adjust."

The change will affect approximately 2,700 rural routes in Canada, 785 of them in the southwestern district. Savings are estimated at \$4 million annually across the country.
