**Police probe 3 fires in apartment building**

Halton Regional Police are investigating three small fires in the apartment building at 200 Churchill Rd. South the evening of September 6 and the early morning of September 7.

Police are releasing nothing else about the incidents at this time.

This newspaper was contacted by an elderly resident of the apartment building who didn't wish his name to be printed, but was concerned about the problem and worried about the safety of himself and another elderly handicapped couple.

Walter Fried, owner of the building, said there were three small fires and confirmed they were in the garbage room, elevator and the hallway near the elevator on the fourth floor.

The police were called after two of the fires; the first was in a bag of garbage and was thought to simply be a carelessly emptied ash-tray with a hot butt in it.

All three fires were out so quickly the fire department wasn't needed.

While the case isn't being called arson, it appears the two fires involving paper had to have been set.

Fried said there has never been this kind of problem in the building before.

New locks have been put on the building doors and new keys issued to tenants. Tenants have been cautioned not to allow strangers in the building.

If this problem happens again, Fried says they will now know it is "an inside job," that the fires were likely set by a tenant.

He could offer no explanation for the fires, short of "there are a lot of sick people around." Fried said "I've never done anything to anyone," adding he owns a nice building and charges very fair rents.

To remove coffee, tea, and fruit juice stains from fabric, stretch stained area over a large bowl, fasten with a rubber band, and pour boiling water through stain.
