

**Regulations, dates to keep in mind**

**What you need to know if you're running or voting November 8**

Election fever is starting to hit Halton Hills with candidates announcing their plans for the November 8 vote.

which both candidates and voters should understand and keep in mind.

What offices will be filled? Voters will elect the following:

1. One mayor for all of Halton Hills from

among the slate of candidates for the post.

All voters in ward one (Acton), ward two (Esqueping), ward three (west Georgetown) and ward four (east Georgetown) vote for this post. The

mayor sits on both Halton Hills and Halton region councils.

2. One Regional Councillor for each ward who also automatically sits on Halton Hills council. For example if there are

three people running in your ward for regional councillor you can only vote for one and the

candidate with the most votes represents that ward at both regional and Halton Hills councils. The persons

finishing second and third do not sit on Halton Hills council, they have lost the election. So after the election Halton Hills will have a mayor and four councillors at Halton Region.

3. Voters also elect

two area councillors. These two people sit just on Halton Hills council and there is a maximum of two per ward. For example if six people run for an area council seat in your ward the two with the most votes sit on council.

4. Public school electors or supporters send one representative from ward one (Acton), ward two (Esqueping) and wards three and four (Georgetown) to Halton Board of Education. Halton Hills has a total of three public school board representatives.

5. Separate or Catholic school supporters elect one representative from all four wards of Halton Hills to represent them on Halton Separate School Board.

6. In addition separate or Catholic school electors share a representative with Milton electors for Halton Board of Education. This trustee votes only on matters at Halton Board of Education involving the high schools which separate

school supporters' children also attend.

7. For the first time in many years voters will also elect Hydro Commissioners. Voters will elect one Hydro Commissioner to sit on Halton Hills Hydro Commission from each ward.

8. There will be a referendum vote on global nuclear disarmament on the ballot. All voters in all wards may answer Yes or No on the question.

Nominations for all posts begin on October 14 and run to October 18. Nomination papers may be filed on October 14 and 15 from 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. at the Halton Hills Municipal Offices on Trafalgar Rd.

Nominations may also be filed on the final day, October 18, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Nominations won't be accepted October 16 or 17 since the municipal offices are closed Saturdays and Sundays.

Someone wishing to run for any office must fill out a nomination form and have on it 10

signatures of residents of the ward in which they are running or voters in that ward.

An elector, or in fact a candidate, is anyone who resided within Halton Hills between September 7 and 20, the period of the municipal enumeration. An elector must also be a Canadian citizen or British subject and be 18 years of age or over before voting day, November 8. If a person isn't a resident they are still eligible to vote if they own or rent property in the municipality or are the spouse of someone who owns or rents property in the municipality. These people may also run for office.

If a candidate is obtaining the signature of anyone who isn't a resident, but is eligible to vote, then they must have the address of the property that person owns or rents in Halton Hills.

By October 12 a preliminary list of electors must be compiled from the municipal enumeration done by the assessment department. This preliminary list will be posted in various places throughout the municipality such as libraries, post offices and municipal buildings, but not in neighborhoods. It is up to each voter to determine that they are on the preliminary list of electors. There will be a notice in the papers of where these lists are posted.

Any changes or additions to the preliminary list of electors must be brought to the clerk's department's attention by October 20. The final list will reflect changes and additions and will be available for inspection.

If you go to vote and aren't on the list then you can swear an affidavit can swear an affidavit for the Deputy Returning Officer that you are an eligible voter and will be allowed to vote.

Voter notification cards will be mailed out before the advance polls (Continued on page B13)
