

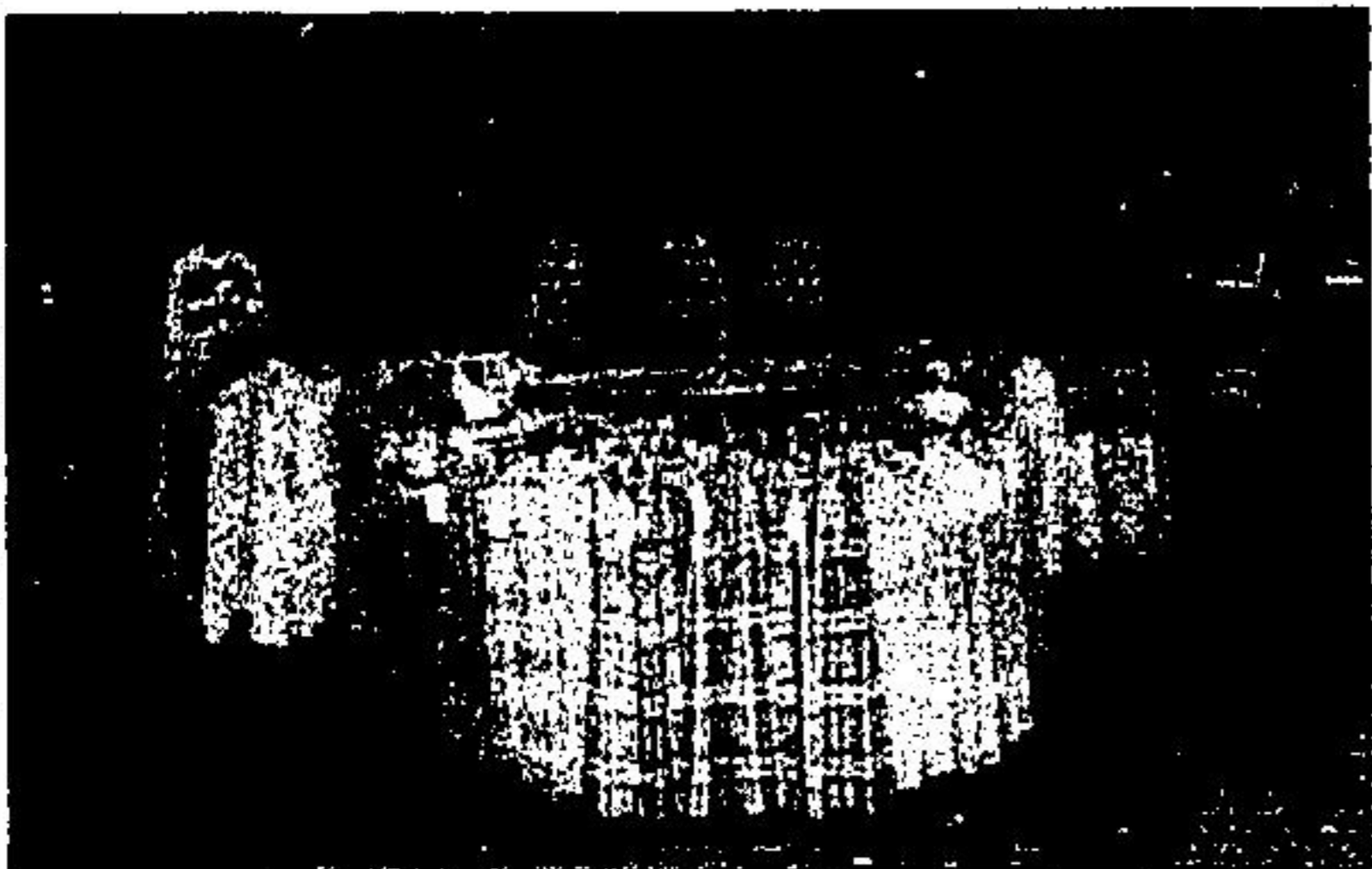


Canadiana Furniture

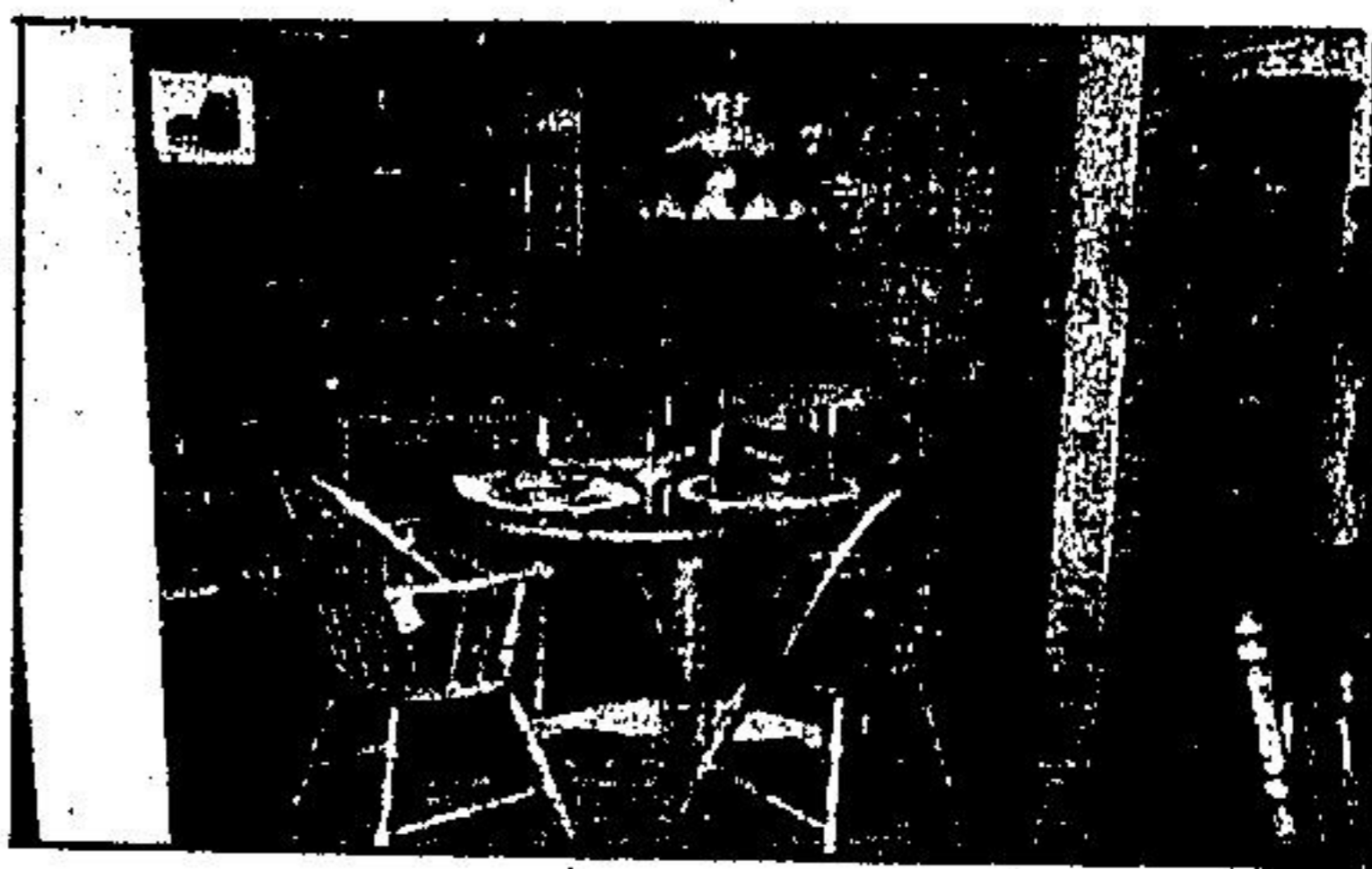
Luxurious Furs
