Free of charge, the Get Well Box is crammed full of creative ideas, including a fully bound manual. "What to do

when there's nothing to do in bed." There are two boxes for kids from four to six yrs., and from seven to 10 yrs. Each has different crafts and materials designed for the age group.

Parents must sign out the box either in Georgetown or Acton and can keep it until their child is feeling

better. If they come into the library to pick it up, the librarians will have some books picked out.

Just in circulation for two weeks, the get well boxes have already been a boost to frazzled parents. "One woman in Acton said she was going crazy and it was a godsend," said Georgetown children's

librarian Joy Showell, who was initiator of the idea. "Older people have library on wheels, so why not kids?"

Joy read about the idea in an American magazine, when it was called a get well bag. But Joy said people were enthusiastic and the bag grew to be a box.

Region's executive structure just fine

Halton Region's executive structure is fine just as it is, councillors decided after a two and a half hour debate last week.

In a 26-page report to a special council meeting, chief administrative officer Dennis Perlin recommended only minor changes to the agenda format currently used by the Region.

Other recommendations, however, did not receive an enthusiastic reception from councillors, such as a proposal to continue changing committee appointments every year.

"I'm concerned about councillors moving constantly from committee to committee, but it's also wrong for a councillor to stake out a claim in one particular area," commented Burlington Mayor Roly Bird.

"According to this recommendation," added Regional chairman Jack Rafita, "we should move just for the sake of moving and we should be very cautious of that."

Under the current structure, Halton's committee memberships are changed at the beginning every year, a system that some councillors feel don't give them a chance to learn the ins and outs of

each department.

"It's just plain stupid to rotate the entire committee membership every year," said Burlington Coun. Joan Little.

Eventually the members decided to amend Mr. Perlin's proposal slightly, to allow some

committee members to be reappointed to the same groups, to provide continuity among the committees.
