Thirty-eight hopefuls will battle it out for 17 posts on Nov. 8

Thirty-eight candidates, including 16 political newcomers, will battle it out for 17 council, school board and hydro commission seats on November 8. Five other seats were filled by acclamation.

Regional council posts were filled unopposed by Russ Miller, ward two (Esquesing), John McDonald, ward three (west Georgetown), and Mike Armstrong, ward four (east Georgetown). Miller and Armstrong were the incumbents, while McDonald was moving up to region from his ward three area seat after two terms. McDonald replaces veteran Roy Booth who didn't seek re-election. Murt Allison was acclaimed to the ward two (Esquesing) Halton Hills Hydro Commission seat, as was Bill Smith, former Georgetown mayor, to the ward four (east Georgetown) post. Both were incumbents for those seats.

A newcomer, Glenn McKenzie of Acton, will try and prevent incumbent Peter Pomeroy, of Norval, from winning his third term in the mayor's chair.

Incumbent regional councillor for ward one (Acton) Dave Whiting, is being opposed by Ed Wood and Vince Whelan. Wood served previously for one term as Acton's regional councillor before losing to Whiting in the last election. Whelan also isn't new to politics, he lost his bid for the Halton Hills seat on Halton Separate School Board in the 1980 vote. Five people, Rick Bonnette, Bruce Cargill, Dennis Devine, Ross Knechtel and Esther Taylor, are running for the two ward one (Acton) area council seats. Bonnette, Cargill and Devine are political rookies, while Knechtel has served two terms and Taylor was on Acton council for two years in the early 50's.

It's a four way race for the two area council seats for Ward Two (Esquesing). Former Esquesing Reeve and Halton Hills' first mayor Tom Hill, newcomers Jake Kuiken and Peter Norton, and incumbent Pam Sheldon are running. Sheldon has completed one term on council after losing in a three-way battle for the Acton-Esquesing public school board seat in 1978.

In Georgetown's ward three (west side of town) area race newcomers Finn Poulstrup, Jim Akers and Phil Carney are running, as well as Dave Barrager who lost in the 1980 election when he ran for an area seat, and former Georgetown councillor Jim Young. Two will be elected.

Veteran area councillors Harry Levy and Marilyn Serjeantson are being challenged by a new face, Michael Ross, in the race for the two ward four (east side of town) area council seats.

Acton's school board election pits incumbent Arlene Bruce, who was for the single Halton Hills-Milton seat on Halton Board of Education for separate school supporters.

Incumbent Halton Separate School Board representative Doug Mason will try to unseat incumbent Will McEachern in the Acton hydro commission race while Georgetown ward three incumbent Ab Tennant faces challenges from two newcomers, Norman Tretler and Ralph Fletcher.
