## The old paper under car trick

When you are handed a major repair bill for your car these days, you don't know whether to faint or shake your head in disbelief.

Car repair costs are climbing and it makes sense to take certain precautions to ensure you don't get stuck with too many expensive bills.

Experts recommend that you carry out a few simple tests on your car to detect early warning signals of major troubles ahead.

If you place a piece of white paper under your car overnight it can tell you a lot about the health of your vehicle. Brown or dark stains can mean leaking motor oil or differential fluid. Pink or reddish drips could be a sign of leaking transmission fluid and a blue stain could mean a radiator coolant leak.

Here is a list of some of the more common problems associated with cars: in-

correct tire pressure, low battery fluid levels, electrical faults, faulty steering, exhaust system problems, worn or loose drive belts, motor oil leaks and defective shock absorbers.

It is wise to check your tires for bald spots, tread wear and misaligned wheels. Tires should be wearing evenly. It also makes sense to use a tire gauge to check the pressure, especially on radial tires where the "radial bulge" can disguise a tire that is under-inflated.

A check of your exhaust system is also recommended. Leaks in the exhaust system are dangerous and are often caused by loose fitting clamps.

By attending to these basic inspection points, you will be in a much better position to ward off costly repair bills.
