## Limit class sizes

The Halton board of education doesn't intend to set a policy limiting maximum class size, but does have a commitment to meet its own standards of average class size, says the superintendent of instruction.

Although there are a number of classes with more than 30 students (the figure the teachers want as the maximum is 30), there are 87 classes with 15 students or less in the academic area, said Ray Stoness.

These would include senior Latin and music, as well as upper level technical. There are 67 classes in the four-year program with less than 15 students.

The board will not commit itself to an allocation formula, but it did add eight teachers into the regular secondary school program, despite declining enrollment. Twelve additional teachers were added into the special education area, but these were mandated by the Province, said Stoness.

He said that no teachers would be taken from the regular program to staff special education.

It is in grades 9, 10 and 11 academic that the largest number of big classes occur, he said.

To add the approximately 30 teachers required to eliminate classes of more than 30 students in the secondary schools would cost \$1.5 million on a budget in the \$130 million range, he said.

The argument that smaller classes would make for better education doesn't exist, he said, adding that achievements of students from this board are as good or better than most other boards.

Stoness said no teachers would have all their classes in excess of 30 students. As it is, teachers take three classes of 75 minutes a day.

Within each school, the principal and heads of department analyse the effect on all programs of the class size of each subject, he said. They would be aware of a larger English class being created to accommodate a small Latin or music.

Some small classes, are being eliminated as too costly, he added.

Halton's average strived-for class sizes are 28 for five-year academic and 18.5 for technical in the high schools.

In elementary schools, kindergarten is aimed at 25, while grades 7 and 8 are to average 32, with 27 as the overall figure, said Stoness.

He said that Toronto may be lower by one student on its averages and Peel would have about the same number as Halton.
