**Welfare cases increase 28%**

A Regional welfare caseload projected to jump 28 per cent this year is placing additional strain on welfare case workers who are becoming objects of verbal abuse from frustrated clients.

David Swarc, Halton acting income maintenance manager, said applicants are venting their anger on case workers making for tense and difficult situations. No physical violence has been reported, he stressed. Mr. Swarc could not give verbatim accounts of the conversations.

"Their (the applicant's) options are becoming fewer and fewer." Mr. Swarc explained. "The problem is that there are fewer and fewer people who can become self-supporting."

Mr. Swarc said many new applicants are former unemployment insurance recipients who have exhausted their benefits. Other applicants are longterm welfare recipients tired of a trek through a seemingly endless tunnel. In both cases, Mr. Swarc said, the case worker is becoming a sounding board.
